## ACTIVITY LOG

### Week of December 08 to December 14, 2023

#### December 08 (39 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a report of a suspicious circumstance at the 2300 block of Sales Yard Road. RP stated that a black jeep was parked outside the gate. The windows are down and the vehicle is occupied. Officers were unable to locate the vehicle upon arrival.
- Officers responded to an animal complaint at the 500 block of Evans Avenue. Dogs were loose in the location. Owners were notified and given a verbal warning for dogs at large.
- BCSO officer assist with a car vs cow traffic accident on W King Tull Road and N Crosby Rd. Driver was uninjured.
- Officer responded to a report of a noise violation at the 1500 block of Sunset Drive. RP stated that there was loud music coming from a location nearby. Officers spoke to the individuals at the location of the loud music and advised them to turn it down, which they did.
- Officers responded to an alarm at the 3000 block of Wittkopf Loop Road. Building was checked and found to be secure.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

#### December 09 (26 Calls for Service)

- BCSO officer assist for an alarm/attempted burglary on W Evans Road.
- BCSO officer assist for an animal complaint on I82, MP 85. RP stated that there is a horse in the median of the highway. Officer checked the area and there was a cow in the median, but the cow was inside fencing and not a hazard.
- Officer responded to a report of a hit-and-run accident at the 700 block of Memorial Street. RP stated that her mother's vehicle was hit while parked in the parking lot of the location on the previous day. Officer advised RP to report the accident on the WSP website. Investigation ongoing.
- Officer responded to a parking complaint at the 900 block of Market Street. RP stated that while he was parked at the location, a homeowner had moved two of his vehicles to box him in and keep him from moving his vehicle. Officer spoke to both parties. The homeowner had blocked in the RP as he didn't want him parking in front of his house. But as the RP was parked on city property, he was legally allowed to park there. Homeowner moved his vehicles and RP left.
- Officers responded to a report of a traffic hazard at N Wilgus Road/W OIE Hwy. RP stated that a female was walking in the roadway, not moving out of the way for vehicles. Officers were unable to locate the female upon arrival.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

#### December 10 (21 Calls for Service)

- Officer contacted a vehicle parked at the 300 block of Wine Country Road (1:43 am). Occupants stated they were just parked to talk. No issues.
- GVPD officer assist with contacting a responsible vehicle owner for a vehicle found in Grandview jurisdiction. The registered owner stated that he had sold that vehicle 1-2 years ago.

- Officers responded to a report of a theft at the 1500 block of Sunset Drive. RP stated that someone had stolen a package off of their porch after it was delivered. The theft was caught on camera. Investigation ongoing.
- RPD officer assist locating a suspect wanted for assault and robbery who was thought to be in Prosser. Officers located the suspect at the 1300 block of Wine Country Road and detained him. BCSO transported male suspect to RPD.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check at Merlot Drive and N Gap Road. RP stated a male was laying on the ground at the location in a fetal position. Officers contacted the male who said he was fine and denied needing medical attention.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint on S 1396 PR. RP stated that there is a horse at large on their property. After this, it had ran down the road towards Les Schwab. Officer were unable to find the horse.
- GPD officer assist with locating a subject. Officers were unable to locate.
- BCSO officer assist with an assault on N 108 PR in Benton City. BCSO investigating.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

## December 11 (32 Calls for Service)

- Officer responded to an alarm at the 100 block of Merlot Drive. Officer found the building to be secure.
- Officer responded to a report of threats at the 300 Nunn Road. RP stated that someone was calling and harassing them. The phone number was from Humbolt County, CA. Officer contacted Humbolt County CA Sheriff.
- Officers responded to a report of loitering at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that there are panhandlers at the location being aggressive towards customers. They are approaching people and aggressively asking (not physically) for money. Officers contacted the people in question, who stated they were trying to get to Richland and needed gas. An officer helped them out and they went on their way.
- Officer responded to a non-injury traffic accident at the 600 block of 5<sup>th</sup> Street. Drivers exchanged information.
- Officer responded to a report of a traffic hazard at Wine Country Road/Sun Terrace. A disabled vehicle was in the roadway, blocking traffic. Vehicle was moved.
- Officer responded to a report of a disturbance at the 300 block of Chardonnay Avenue. RP stated that her former boss had a verbal altercation with her that led to him pushing her. She does not want to press charges and wants only to report this as information at this time. She was advised to seek an anti-harassment order.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

## December 12 (36 Calls for Service)

- BCSO officers assist in detaining two subjects on S Missimer Road due to warrants and possession of controlled substance.

- Officers responded to an alarm at the 3000 block of Wittkopf Loop Road. Building was secure. No issues. Multiple alarms here today.
- Officers responded to a report of a disturbance on Missimer Road. RP stated a male and female were having an altercation. The male left the location driving a vehicle. He was stopped and cited for DWLS and was taken into custody for a warrant.
- Officers responded to a traffic hazard at Wine Country Road/Gap Road. An RV had broken down, blocking traffic. Vehicle was towed to Loves.
- Officers responded to a report of a suspicious circumstance at 7<sup>th</sup> Street/Bennett Avenue. RP stated that there are 2 juvenile males walking on the railroad tracks. Officers were unable to locate the males on arrival.
- Officer responded to a report of narcotics. RP stated that she believes a particular individual has been giving drugs to her son. The RP was told that the individual she is speaking of is currently in jail.
- Officer responded to vehicle illegally parked at 6<sup>th</sup> Street/Stacy Ave. Owner was moved along.
- Officers responded to a report of assault at the 1300 block of Sommers Avenue. RP reported that there are 10-15 male subjects fighting in the park. Officers spoke with the males who advised that they are play fighting. No issues.
