## ACTIVITY LOG

### Week of December 15 to December 18, 2023

#### December 15 (41 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a report of suspicious circumstances at I82/Wine Country Road. RP stated that there is a vehicle pulled off into a no trespassing area. Officers checked the vehicle which had one occupant, who was trying to connect to her work email. No crime, no issues.
- Officers responded to a report of fraud given at the Prosser PD. RP stated that she was having money taken from her account. She changed all of her account information and it was still being taken. Investigation ongoing.
- Officers responded to a report of found property at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated they had found a purse at the location and the purse had several different IDs and several different credit cards with multiple names. The purse is in police custody.
- YPD officer assist with an attempt to locate a suspect who violated an NCO. Officers were unable to locate the individual.
- Officer found a brown female dog at the 1100 block of Meade Ave. Female had a collar but no tags. Pictures were posted to FB and the dog was impounded to the City kennels.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 1300 block of Dudley Avenue. RP stated that a gray and white pit bull is trying to attack her and her dog. This is an ongoing issue. Investigation ongoing.
- Officers conducted a warrant service at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. Male was detained.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

#### December 16 (28 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check following a call from KPD. A wallet was found at Columbia Park for a resident of Prosser. Officers tried to contact the individual, but she was not at home. GVPD was contacted to locate her at her father's residence.
- Officer responded to a request for a welfare check at W CR 12/W Johnson Road. RP stated that there is a male in a white sedan at the location who is slumped over. Officer contacted the male and there were no issues.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 300 block of Nunn Road. RP stated that a small black and white husky puppy is in her yard and she is trying to find out who the owner is. She will keep the dog until the CSO can contact her.
- Officers responded to an alarm at the 700 block of Memorial Street. The building was checked and the alarm was cleared. No issues.
- Officers responded to an assist at the 400 block of North River Rd. RP stated that his friend's vehicle was stolen while he left it running in the location. Officers advised that the registered owner will have to call in the theft.
- Officer responded to a non-injury traffic accident at the 1300 block of Grant Avenue. A vehicle hit a parked car and then drove into a fence. Both vehicles had to be towed from the scene. Driver was cited for negligent driving.
- Officer responded to a report of a domestic disturbance at the 1100 block of Sheridan Avenue. Two brothers were having a verbal disagreement. Both denied physical assault. Officers advised them to separate for the night.

- GVPD officer assist with detaining an individual on felony warrants out of Grandview. Male was transported to BC Jail.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check for a Prosser resident whose vehicle was found in Oregon. Resident was not located and he is now considered a missing person.

- BCSO/GPD officer assist in locating an individual suspected of assault. Officers were unable to locate the individual.
- Officer responded to a report of a traffic hazard on S Missimer Rd/Old Inland Empire Hwy. RP stated that there is a flock of approximately 36 goats running down the roadway. Goats were wrangled back inside their pasture.
- Officers responded to a report of a suspicious circumstance at the 8000 block of S Steele Rd. RP stated that there is a male near the location who is jumping fences and running through yards. Officers located male.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.

## **December 18** (42 Calls for Service)

- Officers conducted a DUI arrest on W Johnson Rd/W Old Inland Empire Hwy. Subject was booked into BC jail.
- Officers responded to an animal complaint at the 300 block of Nunn Drive. This is a follow up to a previous report of a found dog. The dog has been impounded.
- Officers responded to a report of a possible theft at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that several people came in and were shuffling around the store. The RP thinks they were stealing but can't prove it so at this point, no crime can be reported.
- Officer responded to a report of identity theft (reported at the PD). RP stated that someone was using her son,s name to file unemployment claims.
- Officer responded to a report of threats at the 1800 block of Highland Dr. RP stated that her son and daughter are receiving threats on social media. This has happened before earlier in the month. Investigation ongoing.
- Officer responded to a report of a solicitor at the 1800 block of Wine Country Road. RP state that a note had been left on their door stating that if they did not pay them, law enforcement would be contacted. They were advised that this is not a crime, and if someone had a valid claim, it would be handled in court.
- Officer responded to a private property, non-injury traffic accident at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. Drivers exchanged information.
- Officers responded to a report of suspicious circumstances. RP stated someone was ringing their doorbell and running off. Several additional incidents took place at other residents as well.
- Officers responded to a traffic complaint at the 1100 block of Prosser Avenue. RP stated that a very loud vehicle was driving by at twice the speed limit. Officer was unable to locate the vehicle.
