ACTIVITY LOG

Week of December 19 to December 28, 2023

December 19 (26 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a report of threats at the 1000 block of Concord Way. RP stated she is receiving threats over the phone following her husband's arrest. Officer attempted contact with the RP but was unable to contact her. Officer spoke with RP's mother and advised if there are additional issues to please contact the PD again.
- Officer responded to a report of a disturbance at the 400 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that a female whom the RP had said inappropriate things to before was now intimidating the RP. No threats or crimes were described by either party and they went their separate ways. RP was advised on how to obtain an anti-harassment order.
- Officer responded to a report of an abandoned vehicle at the 600 block of 5th Street. RP stated that a vehicle has been at the location for a week and they have not seen anyone around the vehicle. The vehicle was cleared to a local address, but as it was parked on private property, the office could not take action.
- Benton County officer assist serving court documents at the 1100 block of Prosser Avenue.
- Officer responded to a report of a burglary at the 100 block of Old Inland Empire Hwy. RP stated that the lock to his gate and to his shop were both cut. He initially thought items were stolen but then found them in plastic bags inside the shop. He is unsure if anything was actually stolen at this point.
- Officer responded to a disabled truck and trailer blocking the road on Wine Country Road/Merlot Drive. Vehicle was able to be pushed from the intersection into the rest area.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint taken at the Prosser PD. RP stated that her neighbor has been baiting and killing her cats for approximately 3 years. Investigation is ongoing.
- GVPD officer assist with locating a suspect's vehicle. Vehicle was not located.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

December 20 (33 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check for a 911 call. RP stated there was an accident, but officers were unable to locate an accident or anyone at the location given by the RP.
- Officers responded to an animal complaint at the 2000 block of Highland Drive. RP stated that a female husky and two pups were found on her property. No collar or tags on the dogs. Officer impounded the dogs and posted their pic on Facebook. Dogs were later transferred to Benton Franklin Humane Society.
- Officer responded to a report of a juvenile locked in a vehicle at the 300 block of Wine Country Road. The RP was able to contact someone who had an extra key.
- Officer responded to a report of information only at 4th Street/Guernsey Street. RP stated that there are approximately 8 student aged juveniles walking in the area and they wanted to report it as there have been incidents of fighting in the area. Juveniles were gone when officers arrived.
- BCSO officer assist on W CR 12. RP stated that there is a disturbance going on at the location and that her sibling is having people over and shouldn't be and that she is hearing threats to their parent. No assault took place.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that there is a large white dog that has been running around the location for several days, sometimes

attempting to bite customers. Officer was able to contact the owner who was given a warning for having a dog at large. He agreed to keep the dog on his property.

- GVPD officer assist in taking information on a missing elderly male out of Grandview. Male may possibly have Alzheimer's. (Male was later found and was ok)
- BCSO officer assist with a two vehicle traffic accident with injury on W. OIE Hwy. Damage was also done to a PUD power pole and transformer as well as a fence. One male was detained on suspicion of DUI.
- Officer responded to a report of trespassing at the 1600 block of Paterson Road. RP requested subject to be trespassed and he was trespassed.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

December 21 (41 Calls for Service)

- Officer responded to a pit bull dog at large on Nunn Road/Hagarty Lane. The dog was last seen running along North River Road towards the river but was not located.
- Officer responded to a report of an abandoned vehicle at the 600 block of 5th Street. RP wondered about being able to tow a vehicle that had been left for over a week. RP was advised that she is allowed to tow the vehicle from her private property.
- Officers responded to a report of a two vehicle, with injury traffic accident at N Wamba Road/Old Inland Empire Hwy. Driver 2 swerved to avoid collision with vehicle 1 and hit a concrete barrier. Minimal damage to the second vehicle. No damage to the first vehicle. No impact between drivers.
- Officer responded to a request for a welfare check at the 300 block of OIE Hwy. RP called crying, needing help with a prescription. RP was assisted with calling her pharmacist. No crime.
- Officer responded to 2 dogs at large at the 1100 block of Prosser Avenue. The dogs ran back into a fenced area.
- Officer responded to a request for a welfare check at the 1800 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that she was concerned for a friend in an abusive relationship that she hadn't heard from in a few days. Officers were eventually able to contact the female who stated she is fine.
- Officer noted a parking violation while patrolling at the 600 block of New Gate Drive. The vehicle was parked in a no parking zone. RO was contacted and agreed to move the vehicle.
- Officer responded to a report of a traffic hazard at 6th Street/Bennett Avenue. RP stated that there is metal in the roadway at the location. Officer removed the debris from the road.
- Officer responded to a request for information regarding a possible road rage incident earlier in the day. RP was advised to call at the time of the incident or to drive to the nearest Fire or Police Department if they feel threatened while driving.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

December 22 (37 Calls for Service)

- Officer responded to destruction of property at the 200 block of 3rd Street. Officer found graffiti in the location. Investigation ongoing.
- Officers responded to an open door at the 2000 block of Highland Drive during regular patrol. Officers cleared the area and closed the door. Attempts to contact the responsible party were made.
- Officers responded to a report of a domestic situation at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that there are people outside loudly arguing and that two children are present, who are crying. This was a verbal incident only as two people were arguing, concerning custody exchange. Officer stood by for the exchange and advised the parties to seek court assistance.

- Officers responded to a dog at large on Wine Country Road/Nunn Road. A brindle colored pit bull type of dog was running on North River Road. Officers were unable to secure the dog.
- Officers responded to a report of narcotics at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that a male who is on narcotics is in the restroom at the facility. RP wants him moved along. He was trespassed from the location at the business' request.
- Officers responded to a 911 hang up at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. Officer was advised that an employee accidentally called and that there is no emergency.
- BCSO officer assist with a possible DV on Missimer Road. Father reports that he fell. No physical assault reported.
- Officers responded to a report of suspicious circumstances at the 300 block of Chardonnay Avenue. RP stated that when they arrived to work, the door was open and they would like the officers to check the building prior to them entering. Officers cleared the building and no one was inside.
- Officers responded to a report of threats at the 300 block of Casi Court. RP stated that someone had called and stated that they are going to "shoot the house". The residents did not know the caller. The RP stated that they were not going to stay at the home for the night.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

December 23 (31 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a no assault domestic report at the 1000 block of Anna Street. RP stated that her spouse is intoxicated and she wanted the officers to make him leave their home. Officers advised that they cannot make him leave his home. Officers advised the RP to leave but she declined. Officers also advised the RP to call if things escalate.
- WSP officer assist for a two vehicle unknown injury traffic accident at MP 78 on I 82.
- Officer responded to a lobby contact at the PD. RP captured the previously elusive dog running at large for multiple days. The CSO impounded the pooch.
- GVPD officer assist with warrant service.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 300 block of Basalt Loop. RP stated that a neighbor's small, brown, dachshund dog attempted to attack her daughter (the daughter is uninjured). Incident is being forwarded to the CSO.
- Officer responded to a report of forgery/fraud at the 400 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that someone had purchased items using someone else's checks. Investigation is ongoing.
- Officers responded to a civil complaint at the 1400 block of Riverside Drive. RP stated that her boyfriend accidentally put trash in a neighbor's trash can and the neighbor took the trash out of their can and spread it on the RP's porch. The RP was advised that this is a civil issue and to call if further issues take place.
- Officers responded to a suspicious circumstance at the 600 block of Guernsey Street. RP stated that they saw someone pull up to the neighbor's home and throw things in a garbage can and then went to the front porch. RP is unsure if neighbor is home. Officers checked the area but nothing suspicious was noted.
- Officers responded to a non-injury traffic accident on Market Street/SR 22. A small sedan vehicle went into a ditch. No damage was sustained and the officers helped the driver out of the ditch.
- Officers responded to a report of suspicious circumstances at the 100 block of Merlot Drive. RP stated that they had received a dollar bill from a customer with an unknown white substance on it. The RP requested that the officer take the dollar bill and destroy it.
- Officers responded to a report of a suspicious circumstance at the Prosser Rest Area. RP stated that a male is in the women's restroom, refusing to leave. Officers transported male to his daughter in Grandview. This is the male who was reported missing from Grandview previously.
- BCSO officers assist with a report of weapons at W. Buena Vista Road. RP stated that someone was shooting with rapid gunfire behind her home and that a few shots had come through her

home. No one was injured but the bullets came through the window and went into the wall. The RP thought she knew who was shooting. BCSO investigating but appears accidental.

- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

December 24 (38 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a non-injury traffic accident at Wine Country Road/Gap Road. RP stated that there was a two vehicle accident at the location (one of which hit a pole) and both vehicles had left. The RP had then run over metal that was in the road following the accident and had sustained a flat tire. Little info on the accident participants.
- Officer located an open door during patrol at the 1000 block of Concord Way. Officer secured the door.
- Officer responded to a suspicious circumstance at the 1000 block of Burgundy Place. Officers noted a front door at the location wide open. The officer contacted the home owner and the home was secured.
- Officers responded to an informational report given in the lobby of the PD. RP stated that she was receiving unsolicited porn videos/messages on her social media account. She will delete/block the sender, but wanted the officers to know.
- BCSO officer assist with a business alarm on W Biggam Road. Employee at the business confirmed that all was well and that the building was secure.
- BCSO officer assist with a non-assault domestic on S Missimer Road. A father and son were having a disagreement. No assault took place and the parties separated for the evening.
- Officers responded to an animal complaint at the 400 block of North River Road. Officer noted a loose husky and chased it back to its property.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

December 25 (20 Calls for Service)

- BCSO officer assist with a suspicious circumstance on I 82. An unoccupied vehicle appears to be disabled at the location. It appears that there is a bullet hole in the driver's side window. RO of the vehicle was contacted and he had picked up his family member's after their vehicle stopped working the day before. No bullet holes were present at that time. The vehicle had been rummaged through as well. Case has been classified as a vehicle prowl and is being investigated by BCSO.
- BCSO officer assist with a request for a welfare check following a 911 text call. Officers checked the location and found no issues.
- BCSO officer assist for a report of domestic violence on E Hartley PR. A male was detained for making threats and malicious mischief.
- BCSO officer assist with a report of DV Assault at MP 78 on I 82. A couple had been arguing while driving home. Female denied physical assault.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

December 26 (30 Calls for Service)

- BCSO officer assist locating a report of a traffic accident on W McCreadie Road/N Gap Road. The RP was a passerby who did not stop but stated that there is a totaled truck in the road, blocking

traffic with its hazard lights on. Officers checked to the county line but did not locate the accident.

- BCSO officer assist with a non-injury, single vehicle traffic accident on N Gap Road/W King Tull Road. It appears the vehicle went in to the ditch while attempting a U-turn and could not get out of the ditch.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check at the 1100 block of Market Street. The RP had a vehicle that had a dead battery and he was getting cold and had no place to shelter. Officers were able to help him get his vehicle started and he drove away.
- Officers responded to a vehicle that was on private property (that should not have been). Due to one of the occupants being a person of interest to BCSO, the incident was split to BCSO.
- Officer responded to a request for information on narcotics. Officer attempted to contact the caller to no avail.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

December 27 (42 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a bicycle rider at Dudley Ave/Court Street. Officers gave the rider a verbal warning for riding at dark without a light on their bike.
- BCSO officers assist with a report of assault on S 1538 PR. RP stated that she and her girlfriend were having an argument. One participant stated it was verbal only, another claimed to have been kicked but does not want to file a report.
- Officers responded to a report of a vehicle prowling at the 1000 block of Margaret Street. RP stated that someone has stolen their firearm and case from their unlocked vehicle. Investigation is ongoing.
- Officer responded to a report of a theft at the 1400 block of Sheridan Avenue. RP stated that his iPhone was stolen from his locker at the gym. The gym staff shared the video footage of the time surrounding the theft and the investigation is ongoing.
- Officer facilitated transferring of impounded dogs to the Benton-Franklin Humane Society.
- Officer responded to a report of a burglary at the 1400 block of Sheridan Avenue. RP stated that parts of his fence were cut and he believes someone may have gained access to his property. He does not think anything was stolen at this time.
- Officers responded to a report of suspicious circumstances at the 1000 block of Gum Street. RP stated that a suspicious individual on a bicycle appears to be casing the area. Subject was gone when officers arrived.
- Officers responded to an animal complaint at the 1800 block of Highland Drive. RP stated that a neighbor's dog had jumped the fence between yards, with a cable and collar still on. He was able to jump back over, but did not appear to have food and water or adequate shelter. CSO will follow up.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at Wine Country Road/Old Inland Empire Hwy. A collie type dog was in the roadway. Officer was unable to get close enough to capture the dog.
- Officer assist with a request for a welfare check at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that there is a juvenile female at the location who stated that she is sick and needs to get to her mother's home. Incident was split to EMS.
- Officers responded to a report of non-assault domestic incident at the 200 block of Canyon Drive. RP stated that she and her husband were arguing and that she was scared of him. No physical assault took place and the RP left the home for the night.
- Officers responded to a report of a fire under the Grant Street Bridge. Possibly transient related. Officers were unable to locate the persons responsible.

- Officers responded to a report of suspicious circumstances at the 1400 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that a male was coming and going in the area multiple times, messing with the property fence. Officers contacted the male who was employed to work on the fence.
- BCSO officer assist with a report of a disturbance on W. Old Inland Empire Hwy. The RP stated she is having a verbal argument with a male (ex) who is trying to gain access to the home. RP stated that male is threatening her. RP states that the male does not live at the location, but his name is on the lease. Officers advised parties to remove one of their names off of the lease.

- Officers responded to an alarm at the 1100 block of Meade Avenue. Accidental alarm. Officer checked the perimeter of the location as well. Nothing out of place.
