## ACTIVITY LOG WEEK OF DECEMBER 27, 2019 TO JANUARY 02, 2020

### DECEMBER 27 (33 calls for service)

- Traffic stop in the 400 block of North River Road. Driver was found to be driving with a suspended license. Upon arrest, drug paraphernalia containing suspected heroin and methamphetamine were located and the vehicle was seized for a search warrant.
- Traffic stop in the area of North Gap Road and Wine Country Rd. Driver was cited and released for DWLS 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree and Operating a Motor Vehicle w/out Ignition Interlock Device.
- Traffic stop in the area of Alexander Court and Wine Country Road. Driver was cited and released for DWLS 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree.
- Civil issue turned malicious mischief reported in the 1500 block of Sheridan Ave. Male and female were having a disagreement over Seahawks tickets that were purchased a few months prior. The male claimed the tickets were his and stated that he had left money in his vehicle for the female. He also claimed that the female had kicked his vehicle causing a dent.
- Traffic stop in the area of 5<sup>th</sup> Street and Yakima Ave. Male driver was found to have an active warrant and was taken into custody.
- Suspicious activity in the area of Parkside Drive and Paterson Road. RP advising of multiple juveniles trespassing and climbing around the construction site of the new high school. Officer made contact with the juveniles and warned them about trespassing and the dangers of playing in the construction site.
- Fraud report received, RP stated she had been speaking with an individual through Instagram for some time and he had convinced her to give him access to her bank account and to transfer \$3,000 to someone in the Ukraine. RP was directed to file a fraud report to IC3 and advised to call if she learned any new information.
- Officers assisted BCSO with a report of a small blue vehicle racing back and forth on the Grant Street Bridge. Officers were not able to locate the suspect vehicle.
- Traffic hazard in the area of Highland Drive and Mercer Court. Report of a heavily injured cat in the middle of the road. Officers were unable to do anything to save the cat and it had to be put down.

### DECEMBER 28 (28 calls for service)

- Reckless driver in the area of CR12 and Gap Road. Officer stopped and cited a juvenile male for speeding. Juvenile was driving double the 35 mph speed limit and accelerated when the Officer was attempting to pull him over.
- Disorderly conduct at the Police Department. Male obviously under the influence had called dispatch and was complaining incoherently. Male was laying in the middle of road as officers arrived. Upon contact, male yelled and spit at Officers. Officers were able to get the male into his girlfriend's vehicle, but a short time later it was reported that the male had jumped out of the vehicle and had taken off. Male was later located defecating in a yard. Officers transported the male to PMH and he was released pending charges.
- Noise complaint received in the 900 block of Alexander Court. RP complaining of an ongoing issue with loud music. Officer contacted the residence and advised them to turn the music down.
- Multiple burglary and vehicle prowls reported in the 900 block of Burgundy Place. Pending investigation.
- Vehicle vs fence collision reported in the 900 block of Court Street. Vehicle had been left in gear and then remotely started causing the vehicle to crash through the fence of the house across the street. No injuries were reported, information was exchanged for insurance purposes.
- Noise complaint in the 800 block of Ellen Ave. Residence was contacted and advised of the complaint, music was turned down.

### DECEMBER 29 (25 calls for service)

- Officers assisted GVPD with locating a vehicle involved in a theft of alcohol from Safeway. Officers stopped the vehicle and contacted the occupants. Male passenger was arrested for warrants, Providing False Information, and pending Theft charges out of GVPD.

Officers assisted BCSO with a vehicle pursuit that originated in Benton City. The suspect led deputies into Prosser county area on Old Inland Empire Highway. Prosser officer successfully spiked the vehicle in the area of Johnson and Gap Road. Suspect drug the spikes for approximately one mile continuing north into the county and eventually crashing into an empty canal. Male was taken into custody on multiple charges by BCSO.

- Traffic stop in the area of Alexander Court and Wine Country Road. Driver was cited and released for DWLS 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree.
- Animal complaint in the 800 block of Ellen Ave. RP stated she was cornered by a gray Pit Bull and that it had bit a bag she was carrying. RP said a neighbor called the dog away and she was not injured in the attack. Officer was unable to locate the dog. Information was forwarded to the CSO for follow up.
- Request for welfare check received at McDonalds. RP stated there was a juvenile female who had been at the location for over an hour, and they feared she may be a runaway. Officer made contact with the female who advised she was just waiting for her mom to get off work.
- Traffic stop in the area of Gap Road and Wine Country Rd. Driver was found to have a suspended license and was cited and released for DWLS 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree.
- Report of a possible burglary received in the 1900 block of Miller Ave. RP noticed their garage door open, but was not sure if any items are missing. RP found it suspicious that items had been boxed up as if someone was coming back to pick the items up.
- Officers responded to a no injury, blocking collision in the 700 block of Wine Country Road.

## **DECEMBER 30** (19 calls for service)

- Officers responded to a report of a domestic disturbance in the 1200 block of Stacy Ave. Disturbance was determined to be verbal only, no crime had occurred. Male half left and said he would return later to collect his belongings.
- Citizen assist, RP called regarding her knowledge of a person who is trespassed from a certain church in the City. She asked if she could call the police if he showed up. She also said that the church was getting upset at her and wanted to trespass her. Officer told her that she could call the police anytime that she thought a crime was being committed and it would be investigated.
- Burglaries reported at multiple locations in the 1900 block of Miller Ave, the 500 block of Alexander Court, and the 1900 block of Elwood Ave. Sheds and garages were broken into sometime between sunset and morning. Items were taken from some places and not from others. In some of the places, tools or other items had been piled up around the door as if the suspects were planning to come back for them. Most sheds were not locked and the ones that were locked had the doors broken into. Pending investigation.
- Assist in the 400 block of Petra. RP called and said that she is being harassed by another resident. Twice now, the other resident has blocker her from coming out of the elevator. Officer explained ways to obtain a no contact order and advised her to get with management.
- Officers responded to a disturbance and hit and run report in the 400 block of North River Road. Officers contacted two males who advised they were driving through a parking lot and starting fighting. The vehicle struck a parked car and they continued driving. It was determined that the males had an active protection order between them. The driver was found to have a suspended license and multiple warrants. The passenger was arrested for Violation of a Protection Order. Both males were transported to the Benton County Jail.

## **DECEMBER 31** (28 calls for service)

- Burglary reported in the 1900 block of Miller Ave. Set of four tires and rims were taken. Related to previously reported burglaries in the area.
- Suspicious circumstances report received in the 600 block of Wine Country Road. Employee at the Holiday Inn reported that there was a male who was sleeping in his car in the parking lot and management wanted him gone. Officer woke the male up and advised him of the complaint. Male was told to clean up the mess around his car which he did before leaving the area.
- Barking dog complaint in the 100 block of 8<sup>th</sup> Street. RP advised their neighbor's dog is constantly barking and causing a disturbance. The CSO attempted contact at the owner's residence, but no one was home. Notice of the complaint was left on the door.
- Suspicious persons reported in the 400 block of North River Road. Report of a males walking down a dead end street with a flashlight. RP believed they were casing their house. Officers checked the area, but were not able to locate the males.

## **JANUARY 01** (20 calls for service)

- Officers assisted BSCO with searching for a vehicle involved in an assault in the Lincoln Grade area. Vehicle was not located.
- Request for welfare check at the Rest Area. Officers found a highly intoxicated juvenile male who was rolling around in his own throw-up. Male was transported to PMH by ambulance.
- Officers assisted WSP in the area of SR22 and Highland Drive with a male who had driven his vehicle into a ditch. WSP arrested the male for suspected DUI.
- Disturbance report received in the 1800 block of Wine Country Road. RP reported hearing subjects arguing and throwing items around. All was quiet upon officer arrival and the residents were warned to keep the noise down.
- Attempted robbery reported in the 1000 block of Meade Ave. RP stated that a male wearing all black with a hoodie over his head and black mask tried to pull her purse off her shoulder by grabbing and tugging at it. RP stated she was able to hold on to the purse and yell at the male. The male then got on a bike and rode away. A short time later Officers located and detained a male meeting the suspect's description. The bike was also located and determined to have been stolen during a burglary to a garage in the 1400 block of Dudley Ave. The male was booked into the Benton County Jail for Robbery 2<sup>nd</sup> and pending burglary and theft charges.
- Officers assisted BCSO with a disturbance in the area of CR12 and Albro Road.
- Disturbance report at Love's. Incident was initially dispatched as a theft of trailer in progress, but was later found to be two CR England truckers in a dispute over which truck was dispatched to haul the trailer. Situation was civilly handled after corporate was able to get the issue figured out.

## **JANUARY 02** (10 calls for service)

- Complaint of dogs running loose in the 100 block of Columbia Drive. CSO observed a Chihuahua and Chow running in the street. The owner was informed to keep the dogs contained and to obtain the proper licenses with the City. Pending citation for Dogs at Large.
- Suspicious circumstances reported at the Prosser Dam. RP stated they could see a boat hanging off the dam and no one around it. Officer observed the boat, which appeared to be abandoned with no motor, no hull number, and no identifying marks. There were no signs of people in the area.
- Officers responded to a disturbance in the area of 6<sup>th</sup> Street and Bennett Ave. RP stated that her brother had chased her in his pickup and attempted to block her in a parking stall because she had refused to give him money. RP stated the male had also sent her a threatening text message. The male had already left the area and was believed to be going to a residence in the county. Officers contacted the male at the residence and took him into custody for DV Felony Harassment. Male was booked into the Benton County Jail.
- Disturbance reported in the area of 9th Street and Wine Country Road. RP reported seeing a male throw a glass bottle at a neighboring house. Officer determined an argument had taken place between neighbors, but involved parties refused to cooperate further and there was not enough to determine if a crime had actually occurred.
- Weapons complaint received in the area of Court Street and Ellen Ave. RP reported hearing one gun shot. Officer in the area at the time had also heard the noise, but thought it sounded like a firework. Nothing suspicious was located.
