ACTIVITY LOG

Week of December 29, 2023 to January 4, 2024

December 29 (40 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a request for information. RP stated that her aunt keeps following her. She was advised on how to obtain an NCO and to call again if she feels threatened in any way.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at 6th Street/Prosser Avenue. There were 3 dogs in the roadway. The owner came to pick up the dogs and was given a verbal warning for dogs at large.
- Officer responded to a traffic hazard at 7th Street/Bennett Avenue. RP stated that a live power line fell to the ground into the road, almost hitting the RP and the RP's son. PUD was contacted to manage the power.
- Officers responded to a report of a runaway at Canyon Drive/Anna Street. Subject was eventually returned to home.
- BCSO officer assist for a one vehicle accident on W North River Road.
- Officer responded to a report of weapons at Vineyard Street/Kinney Way. RP stated that while driving, something hit their window, leaving a hole and shattering the remainder of the glass. No shots were heard and no other damage was seen on the vehicle.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

December 30 (45 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a report of assault at the 600 block of 6th Street. Two males were fighting outside of the tavern. They had both left in one vehicle prior to officer arrival.
- Officer responded to a report of theft at the 900 block of Brown Street. RP stated that an Amazon delivery of dog food was stolen from his porch.
- BCSO officer assist with a report of found property on W Heck Road.
- Officers responded to a report of a trespass at the 600 block of 6th Street. RP stated that he has video footage of two individuals trying to break into his locked gate on the previous evening. No damage was done and nothing was taken. Video will be sent to the Prosser police department.
- Officers responded to a non-injury, two-vehicle accident at the 400 block of Wine Country Road. Drivers exchanged information.
- Officers responded to a report of a suspicious circumstance at the 100 block of Old Inland Empire Hwy. RP state that there is a vehicle parked on the bike path that has been there for 25 minutes, with the dome light on. Vehicle was gone upon officer arrival.
- Officers responded to a report of disturbance at the 200 block of Old Inland Empire Hwy. RP stated that they can hear fighting and yelling at the location. Officers contacted the persons at the location who stated that he and his brother were arguing and he fell down some stairs. He did not want to report a crime.
- BCSO/Fire assist with a report of a structural fire on N Gap Road. This ended up being a controlled fire rather than a structural fire.
- Officers responded to a report of loitering at the 1000 block of Brown Street. RP stated that there is a male in the area that is wandering around the alley. RP thinks he may be associated with ding-dong ditchers. Officers were unable to locate the male.
- Officer responded to an information report at the 100 block of N Wamba Road. RP stated that her drawer was broken into in her room. She stated that nothing was missing, but she wanted to report the information just in case.

- Officers responded to a report of suspicious circumstances at the 400 block of Petra Avenue. RP stated that there is a vehicle suspiciously circling the area. Officer contacted the vehicle driver who is the manager of the facility. No issues.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

December 31 (83 Calls for Service)

- Officers provided transport to Grandview for two stranded males from the 700 block of Wine Country Road.
- Officer responded to a report of a vehicle prowler at the 600 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that his vehicle was broken into sometime during the night. There was no forced entry and nothing was stolen except for an employment badge. No evidence and no video available.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at Wine Country/I 82. RP stated that they had found a dog at the exit. The dog had no tags and was uninjured. Incident was transferred to WSP.
- Officer responded to a report of a suspicious circumstance at the 100 block of Old Inland Empire Hwy. RP stated that there is a male walking in the area and he thinks it may be a person of interest in his recent burglary. Officer advised the RP that it is not illegal for people to be out walking.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

January 01 (33 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a report of reckless traffic at the 200 block of Ladera Street. RP stated that two vehicles were traveling at high speed at the location, almost hitting 2 parked cars. Officers were unable to locate the two vehicles.
- Officers responded to a report of reckless/hazardous driving at 7th Street/Bennett Avenue. Officers detained one female on suspicion of DUI.
- Officers responded to a report of a disturbance at the 700 block of Brown Street. RP stated that his upstairs neighbors were being loud so he knocked on the ceiling. Following this activity, the neighbors from above were yelling profanities at the RP. The neighbor even challenged the RP to a fight, but the RP declined. Officers advised the RP to not engage with the neighbor and if problems persist, to petition for an NCO.
- Officers responded to an informational report of vehicles parked at 200 3rd Street at the boat docks (app 1 am). Officers contacted the single vehicle at the dock and moved them along.
- BCSO officer assist with a report of a disturbance at the W CR 12. RP stated there is a person outside of his residence that is yelling and cursing at the RP. Officers were unable to locate anyone on the property.
- Officers responded to a request for assistance at the 800 block of 6th Street. RP stated that her ex stated he was on his way to her residence but that he is not allowed to be there. Due to previous activity by the ex, officers checked the location to make sure that he had not shown up (he had not).
- Officers responded to a parking violation at the 500 block of Cascade Court. Officers contacted the responsible owner and had her move her car. No issues.
- Officers responded to an animal complaint at the 400 block of Petra Avenue. RP stated that a pit bull was stalking her daughter, keeping her from exiting her vehicle. Dog was gone when officers arrived, but was located shortly after arrival. Dog was aggressive and growling and was impounded to the Prosser City pound.

- BCSO officer assist with a report of weapons on E Game Farm Rd. RP stated that there are several juveniles with bb guns that were shooting at things while walking down the street. Officers were unable to locate any gun-wielding juveniles at the location.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check at the 400 block of North River Road. RP stated that there are three individuals in a vehicle at the location who are slumped over. Officers contacted two of the awake individuals in the vehicle who stated they are fine and that the vehicle is inoperable. No issues.
- Officers responded to a report of a missing person at the 900 block of Kinney Way. RP stated her daughter had gone missing from Prosser. She was later located (safe) in Grandview.
- Officer responded to a report of a phone nuisance/scam at the 1300 block of Meade Avenue. RP stated that a male had called the business stating he was "Lt. Brian". He became upset when the RP would not cooperate. RP was advised to block the number should he call again.
- Officer assist with questions about some papers that she has that were not notarized. She was advised to contact the issuing county.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

January 02 (30 Calls for Service)

- Officer responded to an APS referral. The person in question stated that she is fine and has no issues.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 300 block of Chardonnay Avenue. RP stated that a small white dog jumped in to her vehicle when she opened her door. The dog had no collar, tags, or microchip. The dog was impounded at Prosser city pound and an attempt to find the owner will be made.
- Officer responded to a report of a vehicle prowler at the 100 block of Merlot Drive. RP stated that a vehicle was broken into while at work. The vehicle was unlocked. Video footage has been sent to PD. Investigation is ongoing.
- Officers responded to a report of a hit-and-run accident at the 400 block of Wine Country Road. RP witnessed a vehicle back into another and then leave. Information was captured on the vehicle that left. The driver stated that she checked for damage and, not seeing any, she left. However, there was some damage to both vehicles. Insurance information was exchanged.
- Officers responded to a report of a disturbance at the 100 block of Merlot Drive. RP stated that a male is at the location being verbally aggressive with the employee and bothering customers. He was trespassed from the location at the request of location management.
- Officers responded to a report of trespassing at the 100 block of Merlot Drive. Two individuals were trespassed from the location.
- Officer responded to a report of a noise violation at the 900 block of Anna Street. RP stated that a neighbor in the area is playing music too loud (11:30 pm). Officers contacted the residence playing the loud music and requested that he turn the music down.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

January 03 (49 Calls for Service)

- Officers assisted with a driver on I82 who was going only 20 mph. She was given a verbal warning to drive at least 50 mph on the freeway with hazards on or to pull over. She stated that she was driving that slowly due to the weather.
- Officers responded to an animal complaint at the 2700 block of Lee Road. A dog was at large in the area. Officers were able to contact the dog owner who secured the dog.

- Officers responded to a report of reckless driving at the 200 block of Gap Road. RP stated that a white Dodge SUV was running over curbs, swerving, and not using a blinker. Officers were unable to locate the vehicle.
- Officers respond to a request for an assist at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that a family member with dementia had left their home and was now at Love's. Officers assisted with getting the family member safely back into the family's custody.
- Officers responded to a report of a order violation at the 1100 block of Prosser Avenue. RP stated that a neighbor is violating an order by revving his engine in the vicinity of the RP. Officers contacted the neighbor and advised him that doing so is a violation of the order.
- Officers responded to a report of weapons at the 1100 block of Grant Avenue. RP stated that they heard gunshots near the boat launch. RP also stated that someone also knocked on his door and he was not sure if the incidents were related. Officers checked the area but did not find anything unusual.
- BCSO officer assist with a report of possible possession of stolen property. This was ultimately a civil case.
- Officers responded to a report of suspicious circumstances at the 100 block of Merlot Drive. RP stated there appears to have been an attempt at a break in as it looks like someone tried to use a drill on the door of the facility. Managers will be checking the camera footage to see if a break in was attempted.

- Officer responded to a vehicle accident at the 100 block of Merlot Drive. A vehicle had become high-centered in the drive-thru. The driver was arrested on suspicion of DUI and the vehicle was towed.
- EMS officer assist for a medical call at the 900 block of Florence Street.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 1100 block of Prosser Avenue. Officer noted a small brown dog at large but was unable to secure the dog. The dog's owner was contacted and she went to find and secure her dog.
- Officers responded to a report of a court order violation at the 1900 block of Miller Avenue. RP stated that a person who has a no contact order is contacting them via text messages. Officers advised that a court order is not currently in place and advised them to contact the appropriate court where the NCO originated.
- Officer facilitated a transfer of an impounded dog to the Benton-Franklin Humane Society.
- Officers responded to an alarm at the 1400 block of SW Kelandren Drive. An employee was at the location and advised there were no issues. Officers also looked around the area but did not see any issues.
- Officer assisted with serving court documents at the 700 block of Memorial Street.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint on Wine Country Road/SR 22. A husky type dog was on the roadway in the location. He then ran to a location that appeared to be his home. Officer tried to contact the owner.
- Officer responded to a report of a theft at the 1800 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that their license plate was stolen. They are not sure when, as they haven't driven their vehicle in a while. Investigation ongoing.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check at the 1400 block of Meade Avenue. RP stated that an individual that receives regular meals on wheels deliveries was not responding to their attempts to contact them. Officers attempted to locate the individual. Manager at the location stated that this is common.
- Officers responded to an information report given at the Prosser PD. RP stated that his friend is missing from the casino in Toppenish. Incident was transferred to YSO.
