## ACTIVITY LOG WEEK OF APRIL 10, 2020 TO APRIL 16, 2020

### APRIL 10 (24 calls for service)

- Disturbance call at Prosser Memorial Hospital. Reporting Party (RP) advised of a male refusing to leave the premises and was harassing medics and nurses. The male had left the area when officers arrived.
- Suspicious person in the 1400 block of Meade Ave. RP advised of a male going through the mailbox at this location. The male was no longer at the location when officers arrived.
- RP advised of three skateboarder's in the 900 block of Market St. The skateboarder's were recorded with the RP's Ring Doorbell camera, skateboarding on his porch. The teenagers had left the area when officers arrived.
- A call came in advising that the RP's car had been broken into in the area of Lincoln Grade. Officers assisted the Benton County Sheriff's Office (BCSO).
- An internet fraud located in the 1900 block of Mountain View Drive. The RP advised he was being scammed via e-mail. Scammers were attempting to extort money from him in the form of bitcoin.
- A suspicious person was reported in the area of Merlot Dr. RP called and stated that a female came up to her with an injured dog and wanted police to check on her and the dog. Officers met with the female who said she is trying to get back to Spokane. The dog seemed to be ok and she said it was her service dog.

### APRIL 11 (16 calls for service)

- Suspicious activity was reported in the 200 block of Merlot Dr. RP called stating that he saw two Juveniles skateboarding in the parking lot and it looked like they tried to get into two cars. Juveniles were located and Trespassed from the area.

## **APRIL 14** (18 calls for service)
