ACTIVITY LOG WEEK OF APRIL 17, 2020 TO APRIL 23, 2020

APRIL 17 (10 calls for service)

- Reporting Party (RP) advised of a phone call from a male, stating he had won a cash prize. The caller then began to get vulgar with the RP. RP was advised to not answer calls from the unknown number.
- A vehicle collision was reported in the 100 block of Merlot Dr. Drivers exchanged information. No injuries occurred.
- Suspicious circumstance reported in the 1300 block of Meade Ave. RP advised of a suspicious vehicle following her and harassing her. The vehicle was no longer in the area at officer's arrival.
- Suspicious activity was reported in the 2200 block of Nunn Rd. Officers made contact and determined it was two employees conducting a check of the building.
- A suspicious vehicle was reported in the 700 block of Wine Country Rd. RP advised of a vehicle that had been sitting at the pumps for over 5 hours. The vehicle was no longer at the location at officer's arrival.

APRIL 18 (18 calls for service)

- Disturbance call in the area of 7th St and Sunset Dr. RP advised he could hear three subjects yelling in the area. The subjects had left when officers arrived.
- Order violation reported. RP advised male had violated a restraining order. The subject ran away but was caught and taken into custody.
- Parking complaint in the 100 block of Malibu Dr. RP advised the vehicle was blocking their driveway. The officers contacted the vehicle owners who moved their car.

APRIL 19 (21 calls for service)

- Officers were requested to Prosser Memorial Hospital as a male was brought in with a gunshot wound. Male had been shot in Yakima County during a cockfight. Yakima County Sheriff's Office (YSO) is handling the investigation.
- Traffic stop conducted in the 1800 block of Highland Dr. on vehicle with two male occupants who dropped off the gunshot victim. Two males were detained in connection to the shooting incident of multiple victims in Yakima County. YSO took custody of males.
- Animal complaint in the 1000 block of Anna St. RP advised of a dog-barking non-stop. The officer made contact with the owner and he took the dog inside.
- Graffiti reported in the 1800 block of Wine Country Rd. The graffiti was later covered.
- A business alarm was reported in the 300 block of Merlot Dr. Officers responded but the building appeared secure and nothing seemed out of the ordinary.
- Multiple areas were reported to have been vandalized in the Wine Country Rd. area. The graffiti was later covered up.
- Loud music complaint in the 1500 block of Grant Ave. There was no music heard in the area when the officer arrived.
- A welfare check was completed in the 900 block of Anna St. RP wanted to check on his father since he hadn't heard from him and couldn't get in contact with him. Officers arrived at location and determined RP's father was okay and advised him to call his son.

APRIL 20 (19 calls for service)

- Parking complaint in the area of 6th St. and Spokane Ave. RP advised a trailer had been parked on the corner for a while and it was difficult to see oncoming traffic. The officer made contact with the owner and advised him the trailer could not be parked in the roadway.
- RP advised of a front door open in a business in the 300 block of Chardonnay Ave. RP saw no one else in the building. The officers cleared the business and noticed nothing unusual.
- A vehicle prowler was reported in the 400 block of North River Rd. RP's wife noticed items had been removed from her car. She then saw a male riding her neighbor's bicycle through the complex. When she yelled at the male, he left the bike and ran on foot. The male was no longer in the area at officer's arrival.

APRIL 21 (23 calls for service)

- RP called and said that he got into a verbal argument with an ex-employee who was making threats towards the work crew at the location. The officer's spoke with both parties and advised them both to stay away from each other.
- County Assist in the area of SR221/SR22. A Semi truck ran out of fuel and was blocking the roadway. Prosser officers provided traffic control while County Deputy towed the truck out of the roadway.
- Verbal disturbance in the 600 block of Wine Country Rd. RP advised a male was highly intoxicated and swearing at staff. At officer's arrival, the subject was sitting in the parking lot and told officers he was traveling with his wife when they got into an argument. His wife decided to leave without him and did not want to come back to pick him up. He was trespassed from the location and was advised to stay at one of the local hotels.
- Dispute regarding dogs in the 2100 block of East gate Ct. RP advised a dog nipped at her husband. The information was passed on to the Community Service Officer.
- Suspicious Circumstance in the 200 block of Merlot Dr. RP advised of a male sleeping near a door outside of the building. The male was found to be highly intoxicated and was unable to find his way to a hotel office. Staff at the location asked he be removed from the location. The male left the location without an issue.

APRIL 22 (12 calls for service)

- Gang graffiti was reported on the underpass at Kinney Way and SR22. The graffiti was later covered.
- More gang graffiti was reported in the Wine Country Rd area. Employees of the vandalized building were notified and advised they would cover it up.
- A dog was reported to be running around with a catchpole attached to him. The dog is reported to be aggressive and was last seen in the area of Heights Elementary.

APRIL 23 (18 calls for service)

- RP advised of an elderly man who claimed he did not know where he was. After officers determined he had no injuries they gave him a ride home where his wife arrived after looking for him as well.
- RP advised of people taking their kids to the parks. Officers advised kids are not required to stay off the playground as of now, but should maintain safe distance.
