## ACTIVITY LOG WEEK OF MAY 1, 2020 TO MAY 7, 2020

### **MAY 1** (14 calls for service)

- Officers assisted Benton County Sherriff's Office (BCSO) in a possible assault with a gun in the area of Wilgus Rd and Johnson Rd. The Prosser Police Department contacted and detained both suspects until BCSO arrived and took over the investigation.
- Officers responded to a disturbance in the Benson Ave and Mercer Ct area. The Reporting Party (RP) advised of a male and female walking down the street and that the female seemed to be trying to get away from the male. The officers were able to make contact and determined it was only verbal. No weapons or injuries were seen. Both parties agreed to keep it civil.

### **MAY 2** (11 calls for service)

- Prosser Police Department assisted in a Birthday Parade in the 100 block of Easy Street.
- Welfare Check in the 300 block of OIE Highway. RP advised her sister was having difficulty breathing and a loss of appetite. The female was transported to Prosser Memorial Hospital (PMH) by medics.
- A suspicious vehicle was reported in the 1000 block of Anna St. RP advised of a vehicle driving around the block a few times. The officer was able to make contact with the driver who stated he was waiting for a friend who lives on Anna St. The driver was advised not to block residence driveways.
- Officers responded to a Disturbance in the area of Grant St. RP advised a suspicious vehicle was following him. He stated that the driver of the suspicious vehicle and the RP had previous issues. Both parties were stopped and told to stay away from each other.

### **MAY 3** (13 calls for service)

- Verbal disturbance in the area of Sheridan Ave. RP advised her brother and his girlfriend were being verbal towards each other all day. Officers made contact but the male half had left the home. The female half stated it was a verbal argument only. Their grandmother picked up the children that were present in the home and took them home with her for the night while the female half sobered up. No injuries were found.
- Welfare check in the 400 block of Petra Ave. RP advised of a child left in the car with the engine running and the windows rolled up. RP stated no adults were in or around the vehicle. The vehicle was gone when officers arrived.
- A wallet was found at a park and turned into the police department. The owner of the wallet was contacted by phone and he advised he would stop by to pick it up.
- Weapons complaint in the 1000 block of Grant Ave. RP stated he saw an adult male shooting at squirrels and birds. The suspect was contacted and was warned and advised that if he does not stop shooting at animals he may potentially face charges.
- A suspicious person was reported in the 1200 block of Budd Ave. RP advised there was a suspicious subject in his neighbor's driveway. When officers arrived, the subject was no longer in the area. There were no other issues found.
- A disturbance was reported in the 300 block of Casi Ct. RP advised his girlfriend's ex-husband came knocking on the door late at night. The male subject kept saying he was angry. The RP did not open the door as the subject is known to carry a handgun. The subject then stopped knocking and had left the area when officers arrived.

## **MAY 4** (17 calls for service)

- A disturbance was reported in the area of 6<sup>th</sup> St. A female visiting the area appeared to be upset and left her credit card in a business in town. The female became irritated and began yelling. Officers arrived and were able to assist the female with some food and water and a donation for the bus ride. The female appeared to be happy prior to leaving on the bus.
- Disturbance in the area of Alexander Ct and Wine Country Rd. RP advised of a female that appeared to be running away from a male. Officers made contact with both parties and were advised that it was only a verbal argument and assured there would be no more issues. No injuries were noticed by officers and both parties left with the male half's father.
- Semi-truck accident in the 700 block of Wine Country Rd. RP advised a semi-truck had hit another semi-truck while trying to turn into the parking lot. Both drivers exchanged information, no injuries resulted and both of the trucks were still drivable.
- A suspicious vehicle was reported in the 1100 block of Walker Pl. RP advised of a vehicle that had been parked outside his residence for two hours. The vehicle did not seem familiar to the RP and the vehicle was unoccupied. The RP later determined the vehicle belonged to someone visiting another residence in the area and no other issues were found.

## **MAY 5** (22 calls for service)

- A trash can caught on fire in the 1200 block of Bennett Ave. A local business accidentally started a fire by throwing ashes into the trash can. The officers were able to put most of the fire out until WBFR arrived. No injuries were found.
- Traffic complaint in the 300 block of OIE Highway. RP advised of vehicles that were racing on the main street. An officer was in the area at the time of the call but heard nothing prior to the call. The vehicles that the RP advised of were no longer in the area.
- Private property accident in the 100 block of Merlot Dr. RP advised a male towing a trailer went through a drive through and damaged some bushes. The driver had provided the business manager with his insurance info when officers arrived.
- Suspicious person reported in the 1100 block of Prosser. RP advised of a male that appeared to be stumbling but was not able to give a description. Officers arrived to the area but did not locate anyone.

## **MAY 6** (12 calls for service)

- Grandview Police Department (GPD) advised they were looking for a vehicle involved in a theft in a Grandview business. The vehicle was at a high rate of speed from Grandview and was not located in the Prosser area. Washington State Patrol (WSP) were also advised.
- Civil dispute in the 900 block of Florence St. RP advised her ex-husband keeps going to her residence uninvited. The officers advised the RP of where to obtain the No Contact Order (NCO) paperwork and to call if he went over uninvited again.
- Fish and Wildlife advised of a possible Prosser resident shooting a wolf in their area. Officers looked into the suspect and determined the male being from Grandview. The RP was directed to GPD.
- Officers spoke to a RP who was having issues with his daughter. The officers listened to his story but determined it was a civil issue.

## **MAY 7** (13 calls for service)

- A dispute over garbage can usage occurred in the 2000 Block of Highland Dr. RP advised his neighbor is using his garbage can without his permission. Officers were unable to make contact with the neighbor but further attempts will be made.
- Injury accident in the Merlot Dr. and Wine Country Rd area. A vehicle failed to stop at a stop light striking another vehicle. The driver was transported to PMH and was cited for Driving While License Suspended (DWLS) third degree and failure to yield.
- Welfare check in the 800 block of Ellen Ave. RP advised of a possible overdose victim due to the way he was acting earlier that day. When officers arrived they determined the male to be fine and no other issues were found.
