**Impacts to City and Police Department Services  
Due to a Large Commercial Structural Fire in the Downtown**

City services have been impacted by the recent fire in the downtown over the weekend.

All city departments are currently functioning at a temporary location and have limited communications at this time with the exception of the Police Department that has full capability. We are in the process of determining a more permanent location, which will be announced to the public in near future.

Street closures remain in effect to vehicle and pedestrian traffic at the intersection of Bennett and 7<sup>th</sup> Street and the alley between 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>.

Recreation programs will be on hold for 2 weeks as we transition into our new temporary location. More information about programs will be made available in the days to follow.
