Week of February 09 to February 15, 2024

February 09 (39 Calls for Service)

- BCSO officer assist with a report of suspicious circumstances at W King Tull Road/N Hinzerling Road. The RP stated that there is possibly a break-in happening at a home at the location. The RP saw several individuals with flashlights walking the home. No individuals were located.
- Officers responded to a traffic complaint at Canyon Drive/Sadie Street. RP stated that there are quite a few unsafe drivers in the area.
- Officers responded to a report of a traffic hazard at the 200 block of Old Inland Empire Hwy. The RP stated that there is a male who is acting oddly, falling into the street. Officers contacted the male who said he was dancing. He was warned to stay out of the roadway.
- Officers responded to a report of a theft at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. The RP stated that 2 nights ago she left her cellphone in the restroom and it was gone by the time she returned to collect it. Video shows a female going into the restroom after the RP left, but she denies taking the phone. Investigation is ongoing.
- Officer responded to a report of a burglary at the 300 block of Old Inland Empire Hwy. The RP stated that her shed had been broken into within the last few days. She did not notice anything missing but will contact officers if something did end up being stolen.
- Officers responded to a report of theft at the 1200 block of Meade Avenue. The RP stated that they have discovered that an ex-employee was embezzling money some time ago. Investigation is ongoing.
- WSP officer assist on I82 with a DUI arrest.
- BCSO officer assist on W King Tull Road/N Rankin Road. An accident alert came in from an iPhone. Officers were unable to locate the accident.
- BCSO officer assist for a structure fire at W Yakitat Road/I82. This was a controlled burn.
- Officers responded to a report of loitering at the 400 block of Wine Country Road. The RP stated that there is a male walking around the store and hanging out in the restroom area. Officers contacted the store clerks who asked that he be moved along as the store is closing. Officers contacted the male, advising him to leave. He complied.
- Officers responded to a 911 hang-up call at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. Employees stated that they are not aware of anyone calling 911.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

February 10 (28 Calls for Service)

- BCSO officers assist for a report of suspicious circumstances at Bettinson Road/N Old Inland Empire Hwy. The RP stated that there are several vehicles that have been parked in the area for a while, along with a pickup. This ended up being a single vehicle accident with no reported injuries. Individuals were waiting on others to show up to help.
- Officers responded to an animal complaint at the 1600 block of Sherman Avenue. The RP stated that there is a dog that appears to have bitten through his leash and was at large. A neighbor caught the dog and returned it to its owner. The officer advised the owner to get a better leash.

- WSP officer assist with a traffic hazard on Gap Road. The RP stated that there are several cows about to merge onto I82 west bound. They were corralled back into their pen and information was given to the CSO.
- Officers responded to a complaint of loitering at the 300 block of Chardonnay Avenue. The RP stated that there is a homeless campsite behind the location that they would like removed. The officer advised that he is unable to take action unless the property owner of the location makes the request.
- Officer responded to a request for a welfare check at the 600 block of 5th Street. The RP stated that there is a female in a vehicle at the location who appears to be unconscious. Officers checked the female, who was fine.
- Officers responded to a report of a theft at the 300 block of Wine Country Road. The RP stated that a male had stolen a pair of sunglasses. Investigation ongoing.
- Officers responded to a report of a traffic hazard at Wine Country Road/Alexander Court. A Motorhome was stalled in the center lane with its flashers on. The occupants were waiting on a tow truck.
- BCSO officer assist with a report of a suspicious circumstance at the 1800 block of N County Line Road. The RP stated that there is a vehicle parked on her property. The RP had contacted the male who said his battery had died. Investigation ongoing.
- Officer responded to a report of disturbance at the 1800 block of Benson Avenue. The RP stated that her neighbor was pounding on the walls and the door. Officers contacted both parties and advised them to leave each other alone for the night. The RP requested information on getting a restraining order.

- Officers responded to a report of a suspicious circumstance at the 500 block of Myrtle Street. The RP stated that there is a subject looking into people's cars. Officers contacted the subject who was a juvenile. The subject was taken home. No issues.

- Officer responded to a report of threats at the 900 block of Sheridan Avenue. The RP stated that she has been receiving threats from a known person and had concerns about it. Investigation is ongoing.
