ACTIVITY LOG

Week of February 16 to February 22, 2024

February 16 (35 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to an animal complaint at the 1300 block of Meade Avenue. The RP stated that someone was beating a dog. The officer noted a male and female cleaning a car with a dog on a leash. There was no sign of a dog being beaten.
- WSP officers assist with confirming a stolen vehicle reported missing from Prosser.
- Officer responded to a report of narcotics at the 2000 block of Highland Drive. The RP stated that a student had ingested marijuana via a vape pen. The officer collected the related items for destruction.
- Officers responded to a report of suspicious circumstances at the 1300 block of SW Kelandren Drive. The RP stated that a white CRV and a black pick-up with four males stopped in front of her house and a male had knocked on her door. She was not sure why they were there. Officers did not locate the individuals.
- Officer responded to a report of weapons at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. The RP stated that they had heard shots fired, perhaps in the country. Officer advised that he had seen and heard fireworks. No gun fire noted.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 1500 block of Paterson Road. The RP stated that they had found a friendly pit bull type dog wandering at large in the area. The RP stated they would take the dog home for the weekend. The RP was given info on a vet who could scan for a chip. This later turned out to be an issue and the RP was given info about options as there is no CSO officer available on the weekends.
- Officers responded to a vehicle at Crawford Park after hours. The male and female occupants were moved along.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check at the 300 block of Port Avenue. The RP stated that a female at the location appeared to not want to leave with a male at the location and the RP thought there may be an issue. The female's brother was contacted to pick her up.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

February 17 (34 Calls for Service)

- Officers noted a male and female in a vehicle under the bridge at Grant Ave/Grande Road. No issues. The couple was moved along.
- Officers responded to a report of suspicious circumstances at the 1400 block of Meade Avenue. The RP stated that there may be a suspicious activities going on at the location. There are people inside the laundromat after hours. Officers found that the individuals inside the laundromat are employees. No issues.
- YCSO officer assist with locating a responsible owner for a vehicle found in Yakima County. The officers were able to contact the owner, who was aware of the location of the vehicle.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 600 block of Myrtle Street. The RP stated that they had found a dog the previous evening who was cold and skinny. The RP took the dog in and was given information on contacting the CSO and other possible housing options for the dog.

- BCSO officer assist on W North River Road for a DV Assault. One male was arrested.

- Officer responded to an informational report in the lobby of the PD. The RP stated that someone tried to run him over on the 18th and he has a suspect in mind as someone he knows has the same type of vehicle. Information only at this time.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 400 block of Wine Country Road. The RP stated that they were holding on to a dog that had been found. The officer recognized the dog and returned it to its owner. The owner was given a verbal warning for their dog being at large.
- Officer responded to a parking violation at Larch Street/Bennett Avenue. A semi and trailer were parked the wrong way to traffic in a residential area. Vehicle was pink tagged for removal.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the Prosser PD lobby. A dog was at large for the second time today. The owner was given a citation for having a dog at large.
- Officer responded to a parking violation at Stacy Avenue/6th Street. A vehicle was parked on the yellow too close to a stop sign. The officer contacted the responsible owner, who agreed to move the vehicle.

A nearby neighbor's dog was attacked as well and the pit bull had also tried to attack a person before running off. The officer was able to detain the aggressive dog and he was impounded at the Prosser Pound.
- Officer responded to a report of threats at the 900 block of Alexander Court. The RP was concerned, following threats from his girlfriend's ex. He was advised to call if the ex shows up.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

- Officer responded to a report of reckless traffic at Byron Road/Sheridan Road. The RP stated that a white Cadillac was speeding through the area, and had ran a stop sign. Additionally, there was no license on the vehicle. Officers were unable to locate the vehicle.
