ACTIVITY LOG

Week of February 23 to February 29, 2024

February 23 (14 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a few folks at the boat ramp (Crawford Park) after hours. They agreed to leave.
- Officers completed warrant services at the 100 block of Merlot Drive. One male was taken into custody and delivered to BC jail.
- Officers responded to a traffic accident at the Old Inland Empire Hwy/Wine Country Road. One individual was transported to PMH. Information was exchanged.
- Officer responded to a report of a vehicle prowler at the 100 block of N Wamba Road. The RP stated that her purse was taken from her unlocked vehicle. Investigation ongoing.
- BCSO officer assist with an informational report.
- Officer responded to a report of weapons at the 1900 block of Highland Drive. The RP was talking very fast, claiming that she heard shots fired at the location during a phone call (she was out of town). Officers checked with the person the RP had said was in danger. He does not live in Prosser and has no ties to the location. No crime at this time.
- Officers responded to a report of a traffic accident at SR22/Paterson Road. Call was split to WSP.
- BCSO officer assist on Buena Vista Road for a traffic accident. One individual taken into custody for suspected DUI.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

February 24 (23 Calls for Service)

- Officer responded to a report of a civil complaint at the 600 block of New Gate Drive. The RP was wanting the officer to get involved in a civil parenting issue. As this is a civil issue, she was advised to modify the parenting plan if she felt it was necessary.
- Officer responded to a report of theft at the 900 block of Brown Street. The RP stated that his electric bicycle was stolen on the 02/21. The RP has video of the theft and will upload to the officer. Investigation is ongoing.
- Officer responded to a noise complaint at Spruce Avenue/Larch Street. The RP stated that a dog has been barking for hours. The officer did not hear the dog barking.
- Officers responded to a report of a traffic hazard at the 800 block of Brown Street. The RP stated that a Dodge truck and big trailer were in the middle of the road. The officer made contact with the driver who politely agreed to move it.
