## NEW FREE DUMP VOUCHER

Prosser, WA: In order to better serve our residents, the City of Prosser has launched the Transfer Station Voucher Program. This new free program will begin in March 2023. The City will be sending vouchers in the March utility bills to each city residence that is good for one FREE waste disposal at the City's Transfer Station, located at 10<sup>th</sup> Street and Sherman Avenue. This voucher can be used on any day the Transfer Station is open within the calendar year.

These vouchers replace the Annual Spring and Fall clean-ups hosted by the City of Prosser in coordination with Basin Disposal. The Voucher Program will allow residents to gather their items to be disposed of and plan their trip on a date and time which is most convenient to them. The program applies to City of Prosser residents with an active utility account, which includes a payment for trash services. In order to redeem the voucher, residents will be required to bring the original voucher (no replacements will be offered), a valid Washington State ID and proof of residency (i.e. Utility Bill or other billing statement).

The voucher is good for one (1) load. A load is defined as:

- A single vehicle or truck with items and/or trailer with items.
- The voucher does not include any items with Freon; charges still apply for these items.
- ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED: Concrete, oils, paints, batteries, or any other hazardous materials.

### **HOW DO I REDEEM THE VOUCHER?**

- Verify your account information is correct including mailing address.
- When you receive your voucher, load up your items to be disposed and visit the Transfer Station.
- Bring your ID, proof of residency and the voucher with you.

### **WHAT CAN I USE MY VOUCHER FOR?**

Residents are encouraged to clean up around their property and take advantage of the FREE voucher to dispose of bulky waste such as furniture, old appliances, tree limbs, fence panels and more.

### **ARE VOUCHERS FOR CITY OF PROSSER RESIDENTS ONLY?**

Yes. To discourage misuse of the program by contractors and non-residents, a valid WA driver's license or state ID, as well as a utility billing stub will be required in order to redeem the voucher.

Transfer Station vouchers will reset at the first of the year and are valid through December 31<sup>st</sup>.

The Transfer Station is located at 10<sup>th</sup> Street and Sherman Avenue in Prosser and the operating hours are 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, Friday, and Saturday.

The City of Prosser is pleased to implement a transfer station voucher program to support our community!

<p><b>How does it work?</b></p> <p>The voucher program entitles the owner of a residential property within Prosser's city limits to one waste disposal voucher. Each voucher can be used for one visit to the transfer station on any day of their choosing.</p>	<p><b>What can be disposed of?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Any non-hazardous residential trash.</li> <li>• Tree limbs, wood, fence posts, etc.</li> <li>• All furniture and appliances; Freon appliances cannot be dumped for free (\$63.97 fee).</li> </ul>
<p><b>Who can use the voucher?</b></p> <p>Vouchers are for City residents only. The City issues the vouchers to the property and are not transferable. If you are a landlord, please pass the voucher on to your tenants.</p>	<p><b>How long is the voucher good for?</b></p> <p>Vouchers can be used as soon as you receive them in your utility bill each year. The vouchers are valid until DECEMBER 31<sup>st</sup> of each calendar year.</p>
<p><b>How to use the voucher?</b></p> <p>Visit the Transfer Station at 10<sup>th</sup> Street &amp; Sherman Avenue on any day that is convenient to you. Present your original voucher along with valid ID and proof of residency.</p>	<p><b>Please note the following...</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Vouchers cannot be replaced.</li> <li>• Vouchers are not redeemable for cash.</li> <li>• Once voucher expires it cannot be redeemed.</li> </ul>
