## ACTIVITY LOG

**Week of January 12 to January 18, 2024**

### January 12 (41 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a report of suspicious circumstances at 8<sup>th</sup> Street/Grant Avenue. RP stated that a person left a car early in the am and has now returned (on foot). No issues found.
- Officers responded to an animal complaint at the 300 block of San Fernando Way. RP stated that they had been charged by 2 pit bulls, who then tried to follow the RP into their home. No injuries took place. Officer was unable to locate the dogs. A nearby yard had an open gate with dog toys in the back yard. The officer secured the gate and left a contact card on the door (there was no answer).
- BCSO officer assist with a welfare check on N Rothrock Road. No issues.
- BCSO officer assist with a welfare check on W Atwood Road. RP stated that his he is concerned about his nephew as he hadn't heard from him for a while. Officers contacted the nephew who stated he was fine.
- BCSO officer assist with an animal complaint at Prosser Butte.
- Officer facilitated the transfer of two dogs to the Benton Franklin Humane Society.
- Officers responded to a report of a Court Order Violation at the 1800 block of Highland Drive. RP stated that her ex has been contacting her children, who are protected under a protection order. Investigation ongoing.
- Officer responded to an informational report at the 1100 block of Colena Street. RP stated that someone is sending items to her unoccupied home with another person's name on it. After checking with the person whose name is on it, the RP discovered that someone is using the other person's identity fraudulently. Investigation ongoing.
- BCSO officer assist locating a vehicle's responsible owner.
- Officers responded to a report of reckless driving at Benson Ave/Mercer Court. RP stated that a black Hyundai sedan is going the wrong direction and almost hit another car. This resulted in a DUI accident at the 1900 block of Benson Avenue. No injuries. 1 female was taken into custody on suspicion of DUI.
- Officers responded to a report of a single-vehicle, non-injury traffic accident at Bennett Ave/5<sup>th</sup> Street. RP stated that their front wheel started shaking and then pulled him into a curb, where the wheel fell off. Vehicle was towed.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

### January 13 (35 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a report of reckless driving at the 1500 block of Sheridan Avenue. RP stated that there is an erratic driver at the location who is swerving all over the road. Officers checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle in question.
- Officers responded to a report of suspicious circumstances at the 600 block of 6<sup>th</sup> Street. RP stated that a male was causing trouble over an ex and was kicked out of the establishment. RP stated that the male has driven by the location 3 times. Officers were unable to locate the male.
- Officers responded to a civil issue at the 400 block of North River Rd. RP's brother keeps taking things from the house and selling them for drugs. The brother was gone prior to officer arrival. RP will call again if he shows up.

- Officers responded to a report of a 911 hang up at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. No issues. Employee accidentally dialed wrong.
- Officers responded to a report of property found at the Cenex fuel pumps on Bennett. RP found a credit card and dropped the card off at the police department. Officer will return the card to the bank when next open.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check at the 1000 block of Meade Avenue. RP stated they can hear someone yelling for help and pounding at the location, which sounds like an adult male. Officers checked the area and found a male who advised he is locked inside the building. No issues.
- Officer responded to a report of narcotics at the 200 block of Canyon Drive. RP stated that he had taped up a sign asking nearby residents to stop smoking marijuana. A neighbor took the sign down and the two had an argument. Both males retreated to their respective apartments. No crime.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 900 block of Margaret. RP stated there is a skinny dog wandering around the area and they are concerned for its welfare in the cold weather. Officer was unable to locate the dog in question.
- BCSO/WBFR officer assist for a fire on W King Tull Road. This was found to be a controlled fire.
- Officer assist for a traffic accident at the 1400 block of Paterson Road. RP stated her car slid and ran into a brick wall at the location. No injury reported.
- Officers responded to a report of a non-injury traffic accident at Alexander Court/Elwood Avenue. RP stated that she slid down the embankment exiting I82. There was damage to her vehicle, but she drove home and reported the accident from her home.
- Officers responded to a report of a noise violation at the 1500 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that loud music is coming from an apartment in the area. Officers checked the area but did not hear loud music.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

## January 14 (25 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a report of a suspicious circumstance at the 1000 block of Margaret Street. RP stated that there is someone in the alley between Margaret and Lilian wearing a dark hoodie, driving a 4D Sedan. RP stated that they grabbed something by a garage and drove off down the alley. Officers were unable to locate the individual.
- Officers responded to a report of reckless driving on I82. RP stated that someone is driving eastbound in the westbound lane. Incident was transferred to WSP.
- Officer responded to a request for a welfare check at 6<sup>th</sup> Street/Meade Avenue. RP states that there is a female in a running vehicle at the location who appears to be passed out. Officers contacted the female in the car who stated she is just taking a nap. No issues.
- Officers responded to a report of a hit and run traffic accident on 6<sup>th</sup> Street/Meade Ave. RP stated that as someone was leaving they believe they may have slid into the RPs vehicle and then left. As she wasn't sure an accident occurred, the RP also left. Later she noticed damage to her vehicle. Officer is trying to facilitate the exchange of information.
- BCSO officers assist with an audible alarm on N Gap Road. No issues. Employee accidentally set it off.
- Officers responded to an informational report at the 400 block of 3<sup>rd</sup> Street. RP reported that there is water going over the roadway. The water department is on scene to repair a broken pipe.
- Officers responded to a traffic complaint at Wine Country Road/N Gap Road. RP stated that the traffic light is not cycling through to turn left.

- Officers responded to a report of suspicious circumstances at the 1800 block of Benson Avenue. RP stated that there is a vehicle that is driving extremely slowly through the streets of residential areas. Officer contacted the driver who stated he was from out of town, trying to find the address of the place he is staying. Officer helped him locate the address. No issues.
- Officers responded to a report of a vehicle on fire at the Prosser Rest Area. Fire was put out and case was split to WSP.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check at the 1300 block of Meade Avenue. RP stated that there is a woman in an electric wheelchair in the area that looked to be stuck. Officers were unable to locate the woman upon arrival.
- Officers responded to a report of a civil issue at the 100 block of Merlot Drive. RP stated that during a parenting exchange of a child, the mother of his child was being uncooperative, trying to leave without restraining their child. Female was gone when officers arrived. As there is no parenting plan in place, this is a civil matter.
- Officers responded to a report of a traffic hazard at 6<sup>th</sup> Street/Wine Country Road. RP stated that there is a semi-truck blocking traffic in the intersection and it has been there for 20 minutes. Truck was moved along and traffic returned to normal.
- Officer responded to a report of a missing person (over the phone). RP stated that her adult nephew had gone missing and she had not heard from him in 1 ½ years. Investigation ongoing.
- Officers responded to a two vehicle traffic accident at SR22/Market Street. Split for medics.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

## January 16 (28 Calls for Service)

- Officer responded to a phone report of a small dog being kept outside during extreme temperature. RP was concerned for the welfare of the animal. Investigation ongoing.
- Officer responded to a report of threats at the 300 block of Wine Country Road. RP stated that a customer was angry that he had purchased a part that was the wrong part. Verbal altercation only. No crime.
- Officer responded to a report of a traffic hazard at 6<sup>th</sup> Street/Wine Country Road. RP stated that the traffic light is not cycling properly. It appears that the stop line was covered by snow and traffic was not able to pull forward enough to activate the sensor. The issue resolved itself prior to officer arrival.

RP was advised to call if the male shows up again as the RP would like him trespassed.
