Week of January 19 to January 25, 2024

January 19 (29 Calls for Service)

- Officer responded to a CPS referral. Investigation ongoing.
- Officer successfully assisted at the 900 block of Alexander Court with getting a stuck vehicle unstuck.
- Officer assisted with vehicle impound at the 400 block of Petra Avenue.
- Officer responded to a report of threats at the 200 block of Merlot Drive. RP stated that a male was making Facebook posts, possibly threatening, possibly ranting. Officer advised the RP to contact the PD if he shows up again.
- Officers responded to a report of a traffic hazard at the 100 block of Columbia Drive. RP stated that there is a vehicle on the road with no one in it and it has been there 60-90 minutes. Responsible owner was contacted and she moved her vehicle.
- Officer responded to a report of a phone nuisance/scam (via telephone). RP stated that someone was trying to scam money from him by calling him, claiming to be a police officer, threatening him with exposure if he doesn't pay them money. Investigation ongoing.
- Officer responded to a 911 hang up at the 700 block of Memorial Street. Everything checked out and there were no issues.
- Officer responded to a report of a traffic hazard at N Wamba Road/Old Inland Empire Hwy. RP stated there is a semi parked in the area that shouldn't be. Officer contacted the responsible owner (who contacted the driver). The semi was moved within 15 minutes.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

January 20 (25 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a report of assault at the 1900 block of Miller Avenue. RP stated that a male and female are fighting at the location. The RP then got involved. 1 female at the location had a warrant and was arrested on that warrant. Another female at the location was arrested for assault.
- Officers responded to a report of theft at the 1200 block of Meade Avenue. RP stated that he believes his friend may have taken two laptops out of his backpack while he was visiting. Investigation ongoing.
- Officers responded to a report of a traffic hazard at Alexander Court/Highland Drive for a vehicle that was stuck.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check at the 2000 block of Miller Avenue. RP stated that there is a vehicle in the parking lot with a possible unconscious male inside. The vehicle was unoccupied when the officers arrived and they were unable to locate the male.
- Officers responded to a report of assault at the 2200 block of Highland Drive. RP stated there was an issue between himself and the coach. Officers found that they had an extremely verbal argument and at this time there is no crime.
- BCSO officers assist with a report of a driver going WB in the EB lanes of I82. Officers were unable to locate.
- BCSO officer assist on N Peaceful PR. RP stated that there is a domestic disturbance happening. No physical assault took place. One male was trespassed from the location.

- Officers responded to a report of a disturbance at the 600 block of 6th Street. One (unfamiliar) female had pushed another female while at the location and then had left. Investigation ongoing.

RP stated that there is a tan Suburban with dark tinted windows that has been returning to the parking lot and parking there. RP was concerned due to the other store being robbed recently. Officer contacted the occupant of the vehicle and he was moved along.
- Officers responded to a request for a vehicle removal at the 2000 block of Miller Avenue. A car was blocking the bus lane. Vehicle was removed.
- Officer responded to an informational report at the 1000 block of Alexander Court. RP stated that his shed had been broken into. After looking at the area, it appears that it was not broken into but that someone was perhaps staying in there.
