ACTIVITY LOG

Week of January 26 to February 01, 2024

January 26 (32 Calls for Service)

- BCSO officer assist for a suspicious circumstance on Missimer Road. The RP stated that there is an unknown vehicle in the driveway with a male slumped over in the driver's seat. ONE male was taken into custody on suspicion of DUI.
- An officer responded to a report of a hit and run traffic accident at the 100 block of Merlot Drive. The RP stated that while parked in the parking lot waiting for their order, a male drove by them hitting their vehicle as they drove by and then continued to on without stopping. The officers were able to find the offending vehicle and the driver was charged with a hit and run.
- Officers responded to a report of suspicious circumstances at the 100 block of Nunn Road. The RP stated that there is a male walking around the location talking to himself (near the hangars). Officers contacted the male who was talking on the phone using air pods. No issues.
- An officer responded to an animal complaint on Wine Country Road/I82. The RP stated that there are dogs in the roadway. The officer did not locate dogs in Prosser city limits.
- An officer responded to an abandoned vehicle at SW Kelandren Drive/San Fernando Way. The vehicle was pink tagged for removal.
- An officer responded to a report of a missing juvenile at the 2000 block of Highland Drive. The RP stated that a juvenile took off from the location and it is unknown where the juvenile went. The individual was later located and was safe.
- WSP/BCSO officers assist with a disturbance at W Gibbon Road/I82. The RP stated that a male on the Benton Franklin Transit bus had assaulted another rider. The driver had pulled over on Wine Country Road and the offending male exited the bus. He was eventually taken into custody by WSP.
