QUARTERLY REPORT, SECOND QUARTER 2020

Patrol

During the second quarter of 2020 calls for service/self-initiated activity decreased 24% from the second quarter of 2019, from 2,061 to 1,567. All reductions in pro-activity statistics and calls for service are a result of COVID-19 restrictions put in place during the 2nd quarter of 2020.

Police Department Overtime

Department overtime costs during the second quarter of 2020 indicates a 38% decrease as compared to the second quarter of 2019. We are seeing a cost decrease of approximately \$4,376.75.

This translates into a decrease of around 101.5 hours in overtime use during the second quarter of 2020 as compared to the second quarter of 2019.

Staff Meetings

During the second quarter, supervisory staff meetings were conducted on April 24th, May 29th, and June 26th.

Training

Year to date training hours combined with pre-scheduled training for department personnel is approximately 863 hours.

During the second quarter of 2020: Due to COVID-19, many scheduled trainings were postponed to later in the year or cancelled altogether.

- Officer Pottle attended a virtual training of Background Investigations for Police Applicants.
- All PD officers completed online CIT Refresher training.
- Officer St. John completed ACCESS2 Recertification.
- Chief Giles completed yearly CIT training.

Investigations

During the second quarter of 2020, clearance rate of Group A Offenses are as follows:

- Clearance rate for Group A Offenses investigated second quarter in 2020 is 19%. Out of 120 offenses, 23 were cleared.
- Clearance rate for Group A Offenses investigated second quarter in 2019 is 35%. Out of 144 offenses, 51 were cleared.

See attachments (A) and (B) for a comparison of clearance percentages between second quarters of fiscal year 2020 and 2019.

Clearance rates are dictated by the type of crime and the resources available to follow up the crime. It is anticipated that once the department is fully staffed and operational, a full time detective will be put in place, which should increase clearance rates.

Traffic Infractions

During the second quarter of 2020, the Prosser PD conducted 203 self-initiated traffic stops/traffic complaints. As a result, 32 traffic citations were issued, which resulted in a traffic citation being issued 15% of the time, or approximately 1 out of every 10 traffic infractions encountered by patrol officers resulted in a traffic citation being issued. A reduction in traffic stops and issuance of traffic citations was due to COVID-19

Non-Criminal Traffic & Non-Traffic Infractions Issued-Second quarter of 2020 indicates an 84% decrease from second quarter of 2019.

School Resource Officer Activities during the second quarter 2020.

Due to COVID-19, Prosser School District cancelled classes for the remainder of the school year and the SRO returned to normal patrol.

Traffic Accidents

During the second quarter, the department responded to 24 traffic accidents.

Burglar Alarm Responses

During the second quarter of 2020, the Prosser PD responded to 29 total burglar alarms, all of which were found to be false alarms. During the same time period in 2019, the department responded to 42, indicating a 31% decrease in false alarms.

Subsequently, the Department invoiced four premises for violating Prosser Municipal Code 9.20 False Alarms.

During the second quarter of 2020, commercial businesses accounted for 24 out of the 29 false alarm responses, which translates into the businesses being responsible for approximately 83% of our false alarm responses during this quarter.

Crime Free Rental Housing

During the second quarter of 2020, one Crime Free Rental Housing violation notice was sent out to the property owner.

Domestic Violence Incidents

Increase in domestic violence (DV) related incidents in the second quarter of 2020 by 14% from 14 incidents in 2019 to 16 in 2020. This statistic does not include outside law enforcement requests for DV assists that the Prosser PD has provided.

Summary

As stated earlier, during the second quarter of 2020, calls for service have decreased by 24% from the second quarter of 2019, from 2,061 to 1,567. We are seeing a decrease in both Group A Offenses and Group B Offenses. Felony arrests also decreased.
