### Assault 1<sup>st</sup> Degree

PRPD Case #24-265

Prosser, WA: Prosser Police Officers were dispatched to a residence on the 1400 block of Riverside Drive for a possible drive-by shooting. Upon further investigation, Officers found the home struck multiple times by gunfire. There were no reported injuries and it was determined the suspect was known to the victim.

Prosser PD quickly identified a suspect and requested assistance from neighboring agencies. The 17-year old male juvenile suspect was located north of Sunnyside and fled from officers. Efforts from the Sunnyside Police Department, Yakima County Sheriff's Office and the Mabton Police Department later led to an arrest.

The juvenile was transported to the Benton County Juvenile Justice Center where he was booked for:

RCW 9A.36.011 Assault 1<sup>st</sup> Degree - Domestic Violence  
RCW 9A.36.045 Drive-by Shooting - Domestic Violence  
RCW 9A.36.021 Assault 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree (four counts)

The juvenile is facing additional felony charges out of Yakima County. The Prosser Police Department would like to thank its law enforcement partners from the Yakima County Sheriff's Office, Sunnyside Police Department and the Mabton Police Department for their assistance during this investigation.
