### Vehicle Pursuit and Arrest

**Prosser, May 19, 2019:** At approximately 10:30pm, Prosser officers attempted to stop a vehicle in the area of the Prosser rest stop due to the driver having multiple felony arrest warrants.

At this time, the driver of the vehicle failed to yield to the officer's emergency lights, and proceeded to accelerate north bound Gap Rd driving through the stop sign at Gap and Johnson Rds. Prosser officers proceeded to pursue the driver and vehicle as it traveled through parts of Benton and Yakima Counties.

With the assistance of the Benton County Sheriff's Office, Grandview Police Department and Sunnyside Police Department, the vehicle was successfully tire spiked. At this time, the driver of the vehicle called 911 and advised dispatchers that he was going to return to the Prosser Rest Stop, and turn himself in to law enforcement.

Officers subsequently took the driver of the vehicle into custody without further incident at the Prosser rest stop. The driver of the vehicle was identified as Ricky Corby, 41yoa.

Corby was booked into the Benton County Jail on four arrest warrants, and charged with attempting to elude, and reckless endangerment.
