Pro and Con Committee Members Needed

As a part of the City Hall/Police Station replacement project, the City of Prosser is considering placing a 31-year voter approved bond on the November 8, 2022, general election ballot to finance the replacement for the City's damaged Police Station and City Hall, including acquiring land, designing, constructing, renovating and equipping space for the City Council and community meetings, public safety functions, and space for utilities and other City services. The bond would cost approximately \$379.75 per year, \$31.65 per month, for the owner of a home with an assessed value of \$350,000.

If placed on the ballot, the City of Prosser must forward names of individuals interested in being on the pro and con committees to provide statements in favor or in opposition to the ballot measure for the voters' pamphlet. Each committee is limited to three individuals, though an unlimited number of persons can assist in the preparation of the statement. Each committee must designate one spokesperson.

The City is responsible for forwarding the committee names to the Benton County Elections Department. Therefore, the City is soliciting interested persons who want to serve on either the pro or con committee. Should the City receive more than three names for either of the committees, the City will select names at random as to the makeup of each committee at noon on August 2, 2022.

Interested persons shall have until Tuesday, August 2, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. to submit their name to the City by emailing or calling City Clerk, Rachel Shaw at rshaw@ci.prosser.wa.us or (509) 786-8218. Please be sure to indicate which committee you would like to serve and whether you are willing to serve as the committee's spokesperson.
