QUARTERLY REPORT, FIRST QUARTER 2020

Patrol

During the first quarter of 2020 calls for service/self-initiated activity decreased 11% from the first quarter of 2019, from 2,061 to 1,838.

Police Department Overtime

Department overtime costs during the first quarter of 2020 indicates a 13% decrease from the first quarter of 2019. We are seeing a cost savings of approximately \$2,522.91.

This translates into a decrease of approximately 66 hours in overtime use during the first quarter of 2020 as compared to the first quarter of 2019.

Staff Meetings

During the first quarter, supervisory staff meetings were conducted on January 24th, February 28th, and March 31st.

Training

Year to date training hours combined with pre-scheduled training for department personnel is approximately 886 hours. Due to the COVID-19 concerns, many trainings have been canceled or postponed to later dates.

During the first quarter of 2020:

Officer Bustamante attended Reid Investigative Interviewing and Advanced Interrogation Techniques.

Officers Spurgeon and St. John attended EVOC Instructor course.

Officer Sparks attended Interview and Interrogation for Investigators and Patrol Officers.

All sworn officers attended Defensive Tactics, Taser recertification, Reality Based training, and LETS simulation training.

All sworn officers completed mandatory quarterly firearms qualifications.

Investigations

During the first quarter of 2020, clearance rate of Group A Offenses are as follows:

- Clearance rate for Group A Offenses investigated first quarter in 2020 is 31%. Out of 99 cases, 31 were cleared.
- Clearance rate for Group A Offenses investigated first quarter in 2019 is 38%. Out of 91 cases, 35 were cleared.

See attachments (A) and (B) for a comparison of clearance percentages between first quarters of fiscal year 2020 and 2019.

Clearance rates are dictated by the type of crime and the resources available to follow up the crime. It is anticipated that once the department is fully staffed and fully operational, a full time detective will be put in place, which should increase clearance rates.

Traffic Infractions

- During the first quarter of 2020, the Prosser PD conducted 507 self-initiated traffic stops/traffic complaints. As a result, 96 traffic citations were issued, which resulted in a traffic citation being issued 19% of the time, or approximately 2 out of every 10 traffic infractions encountered by patrol officers resulted in a traffic citation being issued.

Non-Criminal Traffic & Non-Traffic Infractions Issued-First quarter of 2020 indicates an approximately 1% increase first quarter of 2019.

School Resource Officer Activities during the first quarter 2020.

- During the first quarter of 2020, the School Resource Officer (SRO) was assigned 39 case files, made six juvenile arrests and one adult arrest.
- The SRO handled various incidents including multiple assaults, truancy, threats, trespass and parking complaints, malicious mischief, and suspicious circumstances.
- The SRO conducted security assessments for all four Prosser schools.
- The SRO assisted the four Prosser schools in traffic control, visited with Staff and Students on a regular basis, and participated in various school initiated drills and meetings.

Traffic Accidents

- During the first quarter, the department responded to 26 traffic accidents.

Burglar Alarm Responses

- During the first quarter of 2020, the Prosser PD responded to 32 total burglar alarms, all of which were found to be false alarms. During the same time period in 2019 the department responded to 23, indicating a 30% increase in false alarms.

Subsequently, the Department invoiced six premises for violating Prosser Municipal Code 9.20 False Alarms. Commercial businesses accounted for approximately 59% or 19 out of the 32 false alarms were committed by non- residential alarm holders.

Crime Free Rental Housing

- During the first quarter of 2020 there were two Crime Free Rental Housing violation notices sent out to landlords.

Domestic Violence Incidents

- Decrease in domestic violence (DV) related incidents in the first quarter of 2020 by 33% from 12 incidents in 2019 to 8 in 2020. This statistic does not include outside law enforcement requests for DV assists that the Prosser PD has provided.

Summary

We are seeing an increase in Group A Offenses by 3%, and a 14% decrease in Group B Offenses. Felony arrests increased 15%.
