Prosser, WA: In promotion of good health and fellowship, on Saturday, May 18th, the City of Prosser together with the Prosser Rotary Club and the Prosser Boys & Girls Club, will be co-hosting the *Inaugural Prosser Rotary Bike Ride Fundraiser* event in support of the great-good things Rotary provides to the community.

The Prosser Rotary Club is asking for a \$30.00 donation per rider, for the Lower Valley Pathway ride that will begin at Prosser High School, located at 1126 Meade Ave., Prosser to Palacios Park in Grandview for a total of 14 miles roundtrip; with an option to continue riding to Sunnyside High School, located at 1801 E Edison Ave., and returning for a total of 30 miles roundtrip.
