ACTIVITY LOG

Week of April 05 to April 11, 2024

April 05 (20 Calls for Service)

- An officer contacted a male sleeping outside of the library lobby. He stated to the officer that he was waiting for a ride.
- Officers responded to an animal complaint at Port Avenue/Cabernet Court. There was a coyote sighting in the area. This incident was split to the USDA Animal Services.
- Officers responded to a non-injury traffic accident at Wine Country Road/7th Street. Driver one thought the stop was a four-way stop (it was not) and pulled in front of oncoming vehicle. No injuries and no tow needed.
- An officer responded to a report of narcotics at the 100 block of Merlot Drive. The RP stated that she thought she had witnessed a drug sale. The RP was concerned about the subject driving. The officer contacted the female in question and did not note any signs of impairment. No issues.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

Apr 06 (21 Calls for Service)

- An officer responded to a report of narcotics at the 1000 block of Sheridan Avenue. The RP stated that she found a residue on the toilet while cleaning out an apartment. No issues.
- An officer responded to a request for a stolen vehicle confirmation. Incident was split to BCSO.
- An officer responded to a civil issue at the 1100 block of Walker Place.
- Officers responded to a report of destruction of property at the 300 block of Merlot Drive. The RP stated that an irrigation pump at the location had been damaged (broken into multiple pieces). He stated it happened within the past month. There was no video of the incident. Investigation is ongoing.
- WSP/BCSO officer assist with locating a reckless driver that took a Prosser exit. Driver was not located.
- BCSO officer assist with a traffic accident at SR22/W Richards Road. This was a non-injury accident.
- WSP officer assist at the 700 block of Wine Country Road.
- Officers responded to a complaint of weapons at the 1100 block of Prosser Avenue. The RP stated that they had heard 2 gunshots at the location. The RP also stated that they saw a suspicious male in the area hiding between vehicles. The officers did not hear any additional gunshots in the area but did smell fireworks. They contacted the male matching the description given by the RP and he had no weapons and no fireworks.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

April 07 (10 Calls for Service)

- An officer responded to a report of noise violation at the 700 block of Brown Street. The RP stated that there was loud music coming from a residence at the location (1:54 am). The officers checked the area but did not hear any loud music.

- An officer contacted a female at the 600 block of Merlot Drive. She was advised that she was on private property and she was moved along.
- An officer responded to a civil issue over the phone. The RP stated he was having inheritance issues with his family. This was a civil issue.
- An officer responded to an animal complaint at the 1500 block of Paterson Road. The RP stated that a dog in the area had attacked his dog and while trying to separate them, he had been inadvertently bitten (medics were not needed). He stated that the owner came and got the dog and took off. Information will be forwarded to the CSO.
- EMS officer assist at the 1000 block of Alexander Court. A male was found slumped over in his car. He was given medical assistance and then booked on suspicion of DUI. He was taken to BC jail and his car was towed.
- An officer responded to a report of a runaway at the 1000 block of Burgundy. Investigation is ongoing.

- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

April 08 (23 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a report of loitering at the 100 block of Merlot Drive. The RP stated that there has been an RV parked at the location for 5 days and they would like it moved along. As the RV is parked on Ameristar property, Ameristar will have to request that it be moved along.
- An officer responded to a report of theft at the 900 block of Prosser Avenue. The RP stated that she had a package stolen from her front porch. Helpful community members reached out to her after seeing the videos of the theft, tentatively identifying the thieves. This investigation is ongoing.
- An officer responded to a non-injury traffic accident at the 1000 block of Meade Avenue. This was a non-reportable accident. The parties exchanged information.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

April 09 (33 Calls for Service)

- WSP officer assist for a traffic accident at the 700 block of Memorial Street. A fire alarm had gone off due to a passenger bus hitting a building, setting off the sprinkler alarm. There were no occupants on the bus and no injuries.
- Officers responded to an abandoned vehicle at Sheridan Avenue/3rd Street. The vehicle was parked at the location for 4 days. The owner had it towed.
- BCSO officer assist with an informational report on N Rothrock Road. RP stated that a female driver who is possibly intoxicated is driving an ORV at the location. Officers were unable to locate the female driver.
- An officer responded to a parking violation at Ellen Avenue/Kinney Way. The officer noted a vehicle parked in a no parking zone. He then contacted the responsible owner who stated he would move the vehicle.
- An officer responded to found items at the 1000 block of Sherman Avenue. Important documents had been found at the location. The officer was able to contact the owner and the items were returned to him.
- An officer responded to an informational report at the 300 block of 7th Street. A firearm was found to be a stolen item at the location. Investigation is ongoing.
- Officers responded to an animal complaint at Newgate Drive/OIE. There was a small dog at large at the location which was returned to its owner at a residence in that area. The owner was given

- An officer responded to a report of a theft at the 100 block of Merlot Drive. Investigation is ongoing.
- An officer responded to a report of a traffic hazard at Elwood Avenue/Alexander Court. The RP stated that the sign for enrolling students for kindergarten classes was causing a traffic hazard as views are being obstructed. The officer contacted the school, who approved him moving the sign to a more safe distance from the road.
- Officers responded to a request for assistance at the 100 block of Nunn Road. There was a disturbance between a UPS driver and an airport member. This was a civil matter. No crime at this time.
- An officer responded to a report of a disturbance at the 600 block of 6th Street. The RP stated that a male was causing a disturbance at the location and was refusing to leave. He was gone upon officer arrival. He was later located and taken to the bus depot as he requested.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

April 10 (31 Calls for Service)

- An officer responded to a hit and run accident at the 1900 block of Highland Drive. The RP stated that his unoccupied vehicle was hit, causing damage. Investigation is ongoing.
- An officer responded to a traffic complaint at the 200 block of Canyon Drive. The RP stated that a vehicle at the location was parked too far from the curb and was facing the wrong direction. The officer contacted the driver of the vehicle and they stated they would move it.

- An officer responded to an animal complaint at the 1100 block of Meade Avenue. The officer found a female shepherd mix. She had no collar, tags, or chip. Her pic was posted on FB.
- An officer responded to a civil issue at the Prosser City Yards. A trailer hitch popped off of a semi and hit the corner of a city building causing only superficial damage. Insurance information was collected.
- GPD officer assist with stolen vehicle confirmation. The call was split to BCSO.
- An officer responded to a report of suspicious activity at the 400 block of Wine Country Road. The RP stated that she saw a female in a vehicle at the location who was blindfolded in the back seat. The officer was unable to locate the vehicle upon arrival.
- An officer responded to a report of loitering at the 500 block of North River Road. The RP stated that there is a male who has been sleeping at the location for several days. The subject left the property when asked.
- An officer responded to a report of a disturbance at 5th Street/Yakima Avenue. The RP stated that there is an unusual vehicle in the area that was playing music very loudly. The officer found the vehicle but there was no loud music being played.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check at the 900 block of Parkside Drive. This call was split to EMS.

- An officer responded to an informational report at the 800 block of Court Street. The RP stated that he had caught someone hiding in the bushes at the location and wondered if the officers were looking for anyone. He was informed that we were not currently searching for anyone.

- An officer responded to a report of a disturbance at the 1400 block of Meade Avenue. The RP was confused and was yelling at employees, causing a disturbance. She eventually retreated to her residence. No crime.
- An officer responded to a report of a suspicious circumstance at the 200 block of Ladera Street. The RP stated that there are individuals at the location who are dumpster diving at night.
- An officer responded to a report of property found at the 100 block of Merlot Drive. The RP stated that a weapon was left in the bathroom at the location. The officer collected the weapon and the owner called in to report that he had left it.

The RP stated that a small dog had run towards a male on a bike, running into the bicycle and knocking over the bicycle rider and his bicycle, causing him road rash and an injured wrist. The owner was cited for having a dog at large and for not having his dog licensed.
- Officers responded to a report of a suspicious circumstance at Brown Street/Ellen Avenue. The RP stated that there is a person standing outside under a blanket. The person had been standing in the road previously. The RP was concerned for the individual. Officers contacted the person, who was medically fine but had a warrant out of Sunnyside PD. The person was detained and delivered to Sunnyside PD.
- An officer responded to a report of reckless traffic at 10th Street/Wine Country Road. The RP stated that a pickup truck was swerving on the road and had tried to run them off of the road. The officer was unable to locate the vehicle.
- Officers responded to a report of suspicious activity at the 300 block of Chardonnay Avenue. The RP stated that there is a truck parked in the parking lot and it may be one that followed a driver the previous day. The officers spoke with local businesses and found that the vehicle belonged to one of the business owners. No crime.
