Week of April 12 to April 18, 2024

April 12 (20 Calls for Service)

- Officers conducted a search warrant on an impounded vehicle.
- An officer responded to a traffic accident with possible injury at 7th Street/Wine Country Road. One driver was cited for following the other driver too closely.
- Officers responded to a report of a disturbance at the 1400 block of Stacy Avenue. The RP stated that there is a male at the location who is getting verbal with the staff, demanding free items, videotaping the staff. The officers moved him along.
- An officer pink-tagged a vehicle as abandoned at the 1400 block of Meade Avenue.
