## ACTIVITY LOG

Week of April 19 to April 25, 2024

### April 19 (26 Calls for Service)

- BCSO officer assist for a suspicious circumstance on North River Road. The RP was concerned about a vehicle that parks in the area every night for over a month. The truck belongs to a person who visits someone at the location. No issues.
- An officer responded to a report of reckless driving at 6<sup>th</sup> Street/Dudley Avenue. The RP stated that a male on a motorcycle cut them off and sped away. The officer was unable to locate the motorcyclist.
- Officers responded to a disturbance at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. The RP stated that there is a female at the location causing a disturbance in the women's bathroom. The female was trespassed from the location.
- An officer responded to a report of reckless traffic at Larch Street/Spruce Avenue. The RP stated that a black shiny pickup drove by the area two days in a row with a 4 year old child riding ON the cab of the truck. The officer was unable to locate the truck.
- EMS officer assist for a medical incident. No crime.
- An officer responded to a request for an assist at the Prosser Rest Area. The RP requested that her vehicle not be towed while she waits to get it repaired. She was advised to call WSP as the rest area is their jurisdiction.

- Officers responded to a report of narcotics at the 300 block of Chardonnay Avenue. The RP stated that there is a male at the location who has narcotics paraphernalia and is hanging around the building. The officers located the male and moved him along.

## April 21 (16 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to an animal complaint at the 400 block of Petra Avenue. The RP stated that there are two small dogs at large in the area. They do not appear to be aggressive, but they are harassing dog walkers. The officer advised that the CSO will be informed.
