ACTIVITY LOG Week of March 01 to March 07, 2024

March 01 (20 Calls for Service)

- Officers assisted with the removal of a disabled vehicle from the road at W SR 221/SR 22.
- Officers assisted with confirming a stolen weapon from a county in Texas.
- Officers responded to a report of a vehicle prowler happening at the 1100 block of Meade Avenue. The RP stated that there is a subject at the location who appears to be trying to get into a vehicle. The officer contacted the subject who had locked himself out of his vehicle and was trying to get back into it. The officer gave the subject a courtesy ride to his home.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check at the 1300 block of Mustang Court. A watch worn by the home owner alerted a fall with no response. Split to EMS.
- Officers served a criminal trespass for the 400 block of Wine Country Road for an incident that happened last week. No crime at this time.
- Officer assisted BCSO to confirm a stolen weapon.
- Officer responded to a request for assistance with an abandoned vehicle at the 100 block of Merlot Drive. The RP stated that a vehicle had been parked at the location for 4-5 days and they wanted it towed. Management elected to have it towed from the parking lot.
- Officers responded to a report of suspicious circumstances at the 600 block of Merlot Drive. The RP stated there is a male in the area carrying a large metal rod. The officers spoke with a male in the area.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

March 02 (22 Calls for Service)

- Officers attempted to perform a welfare check at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. An RP had called in wanting to speak to officers concerning domestic violence support. She stated that a male had become verbal with her this evening and that incidents had happened previously as well (at her home). Officers were unable to make contact with the caller and did not see anyone at the location of the call. Due to the address of the caller, the call was split to BCSO.
- Officer assisted with a disabled vehicle at W Richards Road/SW Bennett Avenue. The driver had a bad battery connection. The officer assisted with getting a better connection so the driver could get home.
- SSPD officer assist with detaining a subject suspected of theft out of Sunnyside. The female was detained by Prosser officers and was picked up at the police department by SSPD.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

March 03 (17 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a report of an assault at the 1100 block of Sheridan Avenue. The RP stated that two males are getting physical at the location. This was a domestic assault between brothers. One male was arrested and taken to BC jail.

- Officers conducted **multiple** traffic stops.

March 04 (23 Calls for Service)

- Officer responded to a traffic hazard at SR22/Wine Country Road. A tractor-trailer had become disabled in the left turn lane at the location. Another trucker assisted getting the vehicle off of the roadway.
- Officers arrested two subjects for warrants during a traffic stop at I 82/N Gap Road. Subjects were booked into BC jail.
- Officer responded to a parking violation at Petra Ave/Basalt Loop. The vehicle was parked in a no parking zone. The officer pink tagged the vehicle for removal.
- Officer responded to a report of a vehicle theft at the 400 block of Petra Avenue. The RP stated that his vehicle was stolen sometime in the last few days. Vehicle was actually not stolen, but was at the mechanics.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 400 block of Wine Country Road. The RP stated that there was a dog wandering around the area. The dog was not located upon officer arrival.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 1100 block of Meade Avenue. The RP stated that they had found a friendly dog between Grandview and Prosser on the backroads. Split to BCSO due to the location that the dog was found.
- Officer responded to an informational report at the 1400 block of Prosser Avenue. The RP stated that there is a male at the location who is yelling and cursing into his phone. No crime at this time.
- Officers responded to a report of reckless traffic at 8th Street/Bennett Avenue. A jeep had become stuck on the railroad tracks at the location. BNSF stopped through traffic until the jeep could be moved from the tracks, which was done with the help of bystanders. The driver was cited for reckless driving.
- Officers responded to an informational report at the 400 block of Wine Country Road. The RP stated that there is a male at the location who is rollerblading in the parking lot and they are concerned that he may get hit by a car.
- Officer responded to a report of a noise violation at the 1000 block of Hemlock Street. The RP stated that there is a dog continuously barking at the location.

March 05 (19 Calls for Service)

- BCSO officer assist with a report of a domestic assault on S Missimer Road. The RP stated that two brothers were fighting. One male was taken into custody for domestic violence.

- Officers responded to an informational report at the 1000 block of Sherman Avenue. The RP stated that there is a woman that has been hanging around that she believes has been trespassed from the location. The RP was given advice on resolving the situation.
- Officer responded to a report of a traffic accident at the 1500 block of Paterson Road. The RP stated that while backing up, he had tapped the bumper of another vehicle. He was advised to exchange information. This was on private property and was a non-reportable accident.

March 06 (28 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a report of suspicious circumstances at the 300 block of Wine Country Road. The RP stated that there are suspicious individuals at the location. The RP also stated that they were attempting to gain access at a location nearby (that was closed). Officers were unable to locate the individuals in question. The nearby location was checked and there were no signs of forced entry. The building was secure.
- BCSO officer assist with a report of a burglary at the 6000 block of N. Gap Road. The RP stated that his work trailer had been broken into (the lock was cut). He will make a list of missing items for the officers. Investigation is ongoing.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 1300 block of SW Kelandren. The RP stated that there is a German shepherd on her property and that this is an ongoing issue. The officer did not locate a dog at large in the area.
- Officers responded to a request for assistance on a civil issue. The RP stated that she wanted an officer to be present while she collects a vehicle that was not being paid for as agreed. She was advised that this is a civil issue and that the officer will not be able to attend.
- Officer responded to an informational report at the 1100 block of Bennett Avenue. The RP stated that a delivery truck from a nearby business was using her private driveway. The officer advised the nearby business to have the delivery driver use a different entry driveway rather than the private one.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 300 block of Casi Court. A small dog with a collar and tags was at large in the area. The officer followed the dog to its home and the officer was able to contact the owner about the dog.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 1300 block of S Heartland PR. The RP stated that a dog was in her yard currently and it is an ongoing issue. The officer impounded the dog which was then picked up by the owner.
- Officers responded to a report of suspicious circumstances at the 300 block of Wine Country Road. The RP stated that it appears that two individuals may be trying to break into motorhomes in the area. The area was checked and no one was on the property. No crime was evident.
- Officer responded to a report of a traffic hazard on SR22. Two semis were pulled over at the location. Incident was split to WSP.
- Officers responded to a request for assistance at the 300 block of Wine Country Road. The RP stated that he had left his wallet at the location and a customer had taken the wallet to return it to the RP. The RP was upset that a customer had been allowed to take the wallet. Prior to officer arrival, the customer who had taken the wallet returned to the location and returned his wallet. The RP requested to cancel the report.
