ACTIVITY LOG Week of March 08 to March 14, 2024

March 08 (19 Calls for Service)

- Officer responded to a report of a hit and run accident at the 300 block of Wine Country Road. The driver of the vehicle that was struck flagged down an officer and stated that a flat-bed pickup had struck his vehicle and then left the area. Nearby businesses stated that they have footage of the fleeing vehicle. This investigation is ongoing.
- Officers responded to an alarm at the 100 block of Merlot Drive. There was an open window at the facility and no employees were on site (after closing). There had been no entry into the facility and employees came to secure the building.
- WBFR officers assist with a fire that was a false alarm.
- Officer responded to an informational report at the 1100 block of Meade Avenue. The RP stated that a semi driver was driving through her private parking lot. She had tried to tell the driver to not drive through the lot, but he had told her he can drive where he likes.
- Officers responded to a traffic accident with minor injuries at Wine Country Road/SR22. One vehicle had struck another in the side, pushing it into a utility pole. One driver was cited for failure to yield.
- Officers responded to a report of trespass at the 400 block of Wine Country Road. The RP stated that a male who has been trespassed from the location was seen inside the business. The RP will provide the officer with video footage of the trespasser.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check at the 900 block of 7th Street. The RP stated that a male was spending an excessive amount of time in the restroom at the facility. When checked on, the male was slumped over. Officers were called as well as medics. The male was breathing and conscious and walked away from the medics.
- Officer responded to an informational report in the PD lobby. The RP stated that last week her ex had used a spare key to gain access to her residence without permission. She did not want to press charges, but wanted to make sure it was documented.
- Officer responded to a report of property found at the 800 block of Wine Country Road. The RP stated that he had found a credit card on the road near his business. The officer collected the card which was a promotional card. No issues.
- BCSO officer assist with a report of domestic violence on N Peaceful PR. One male was arrested on DV assault charges and taken to BC jail.
- BCSO and WBFR officer assist for a report of a downed utility pole (possibly from a car hitting it, though no suspect car was in the area). The RPs stated that a power line was over a fence and was sparking and smoldering.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

March 09 (20 Calls for Service)

- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 100 block of SW Malibu Dr. The RP stated that a German shepherd is at large in the area. Animal control was not available.
- Officers responded to an informational report at the 1400 block of Sunset Drive. The RP stated that her fiancé's car had been gone through. It appears that only rx drugs were taken. The RP's fiancé did not want to pursue a police report. Information only at this time.

- BCSO and WBFR officer assist on W CR 12. The RP stated that her son was not breathing. Medics checked the son, who stated he was fine and his mom had woke him from sleeping. He refused additional assistance from the medics.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check at the 1300 block of Sommers Avenue. The RP stated that a male was wandering in the area acting erratic. She was concerned, as the park was full of juveniles. The officers contacted the male, who stated he was having no issues. He left the area.
- Officer responded to a 911 hang up. Apparently a lot of yelling was taking place on the call prior to the hang-up. The officer contacted the caller who stated that the call was an accident and that the yelling was her and her friends playing video games. No issues were noted.
- Officer was notified of a vehicle impound taking place at the 1800 block of Wine Country Road. No issues.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. The RP stated that there is a white lab in the area that appears to be tied up to a fence with no food or water. The officer will have the CSO follow up.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

March 10 (20 Calls for Service)

- BCSO officer assist with a 911 hang up. The RP was yelling prior to hang up. The officer was unable to locate anyone at the location and repeated attempts to contact the phone number were unanswered.
- Officer responded to an alarm at the 1800 block of Wine Country Road. Multiple alarms at the location had been triggered. The officer spoke with an employee who stated that there are no issues.
- BCSO and WBFR officer assist with a DUI accident on N Griffin Road/W Snipes Road. Several occupants of the vehicle were taken to the hospital with injuries. One male was taken into custody for DUI.
- Pasco PD officer assist with a warrant arrest at the Prosser rest area. One male was taken into custody and delivered to Pasco PD jail.
- Officers responded to an informational report about a hit and run vehicle out of Yakima country that was headed through the Prosser area. The vehicle was not located.
- Officers responded to an alarm at the 600 block of Frontier Road. The responsible person stated maintenance was on site and requested to cancel the alarm. No issues found.
- Officers responded to a report of a disturbance at the 300 block of 7th Street. The RP stated that there is a male in the alley at the location who is yelling as he is walking around the location. The officers contacted the individual who stated he was arguing with his wife on the phone. No issues found.
- Officer responded to an informational report at Sunset Drive/Paterson Road. The RP stated that there are 3 young children out walking a puppy with no adult present.
- Officers responded to a report of suspicious circumstances at the 300 block of Wine Country Road. The RP stated that there is a vehicle that has been parked at the location since last night. A female had asked to leave the vehicle for a little while, but never returned for it. The RP was advised that she can call a tow truck if she likes. (The vehicle was later towed).
- Officer responded to an alarm at the 300 block of Merlot Drive. Prior to officer arrival, the owned canceled the alarm as he noted that a flap was setting off the alarm. No issues.
- BCSO/EMS officer assist with a medical incident at the 800 block of Higdon Road.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check at the 1300 block of Sommers Avenue. The RP stated that she is concerned about her friend who is homeless. Officers checked the area for the friend but did not locate him.

March 11 (21 Calls for Service)

- Officer responded to a report of reckless traffic on Wine Country Road/I 82. The RP stated that a vehicle was passing in a no passing zone, speeding, and cutting in front of traffic at the location. Officer was unable to locate the vehicle in question. Incident split to WSP.
- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the 400 block of Wine Country Road. This is an ongoing issue with this particular dog and this particular parking lot. The dog was posted on FB to attempt locating the owner. The dog was eventually reunited with the owner.
- Officer responded to a request for information on civil issues at the 900 block of Alexander Court. She was given information concerning her situation.
- Officers responded to a CPS report. Investigation ongoing.
- Officers responded to a report of a non-injury traffic accident on Merlot Drive. This was a non-reportable accident with minor damage. An exchange of info was done at the scene.
- Officer responded to a request for a welfare check at the 1000 block of Park Avenue. The RP disconnected. As this was a medical issue, it was split to EMS.
- Officers responded to an animal complaint at the 900 block of Sheridan Avenue. Two dogs were at large in the area. The officer secured one dog and a citizen flagged him down stating one of the two dogs had killed the neighbor's chickens. The other dog was secured in town.
- Officer responded to a report of a residential alarm at the 1100 block of Claire Street. The responsible person said it was an accident and that she had forgotten the passcode.
- Officer contacted the driver of a semi parked in the middle of SR 22. The truck was not disabled and the driver was instructed to move along.
- Officer responded to a traffic stop at Alexander Court/Paterson Road. The traffic stop resulted in one male being arrested for driving with a suspended license. He was transported and booked into BC jail.

- Officer responded to an animal complaint at the Prosser PD. The RP stated that she found a male chocolate lab in Grandview. She was advised that we don't take dogs found outside of city limits. She was given information for local shelters.
