ACTIVITY LOG Week of March 22 to March 28, 2024

March 22 (29 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a report of a disturbance at the Gateway Chevron on Merlot Drive. The RP stated that they would like a male trespassed that had been causing a disturbance at the location for several days. The male was trespassed.
- Officers responded to a report of loitering at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. One female was having issues at the location. She was moved along.
- Officers responded to a request for a welfare check at the 2000 block of Highland Drive following a 911 hang up. Officers talked to the staff and security at the location. No issues were discovered.
- BCSO officer assist with a report of a stolen vehicle. The subject was eventually arrested and booked into BC jail.
- BCSO officer assist for a welfare check on W Byron Road. Incident was split to medics.
- Officers performed follow up activities for several cases.
- Officers conducted multiple traffic stops.

March 23 (26 Calls for Service)

- Officers responded to a report of a noise violation at the 500 block of Cascade Court. The RP stated that a home at the location was having a loud party and that vehicles were parked illegally. The officers did not hear loud music, but advised the homeowner where the party was located to have the cars moved off of the sidewalk.
- An officer responded to an informational report at the 200 block of Gap Road. The RP stated that his shed had recently been broken into and that this is an ongoing issue. Nothing was stolen at this time. There is video of a female being near the shed which will be sent to the officer.
- Officers responded to a report of a traffic hazard at Brock Court/Meade Avenue. The RP stated that there is flooding on the roadway. Public works were in the area clearing up the drains.

- An officer responded to an animal complaint at the 100 block of Nunn Road. The officer located two dogs at large in the area. The dogs were secured in the officer's vehicle, but the owner showed up and took the dogs. He was given a verbal warning for dogs at large.

The RP stated that trucks were parked in such a way as to not allow other trucks to pass and they were refusing to move.
