ACTIVITY LOG Week of May 03 to May 09, 2024

May 03 (28 Calls for Service)

- BCSO officer assist for a report of a burglary on King Tull Road. BCSO is investigating this report.
- BCSO officer assist for a non-injury blocking accident at W CR12/W Johnson Road. An excavator hit the bridge and fell under it (no water was present). There was minor damage to the railroad bridge, stopping CWR train traffic as well as vehicle traffic. The excavator was eventually moved from the roadway. No injuries.
- BCSO officer assist with a report of a missing child on W North River Road. The child was located with his dad. No issues.
- An officer responded to a report of a parking violation at the 300 block of Chardonnay Avenue. The RP stated that a vehicle is parked in a handicap parking spot and that a dumpster has been placed in a handicap spot as well. The officer contacted the owner of the vehicle, who stated he will move the vehicle. Basin Disposal will have to move the dumpster.
- An officer responded to an animal complaint at the 500 block of Wine Country Road. The RP stated that neighbors have been gone for several days and two dogs are on the property. Investigation is ongoing.
- An officer responded to a report of reckless driving at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. The RP stated that a van was driving all over the road. The vehicle was located but was parked and unoccupied.
- BCSO officer assist with a request for a welfare check at W Old Inland Empire Hwy.
- An officer facilitated the transfer of two dogs to Benton Franklin Humane Society.
- Officers responded to an animal complaint at N Old Inland Empire Hwy/Grande Road. A male lab was on the roadway. An officer found the dog, who had a chip and was able to reunite the dog and owner, who lives in Grandview.
- An officer responded to a report of a civil issue at the 1000 block of Sadie Street. This was a child visitation issue and the RP was advised to handle the issue in family court. No crime.
- An officer responded to an informational report at the 1200 block of Prosser Avenue. The RP stated that there is supposed to be a fight after the school dance. The officer checked the area in question and there were no individuals at the location.
- An officer responded to a report of a hit and run accident at the 400 block of Wine Country Road. The RP stated that an unknown vehicle had struck her parked car while she was shopping. No injuries. Investigation is ongoing.
- An officer responded to a report of property found at the 700 block of Wine Country Road. The RP stated that a suitcase with tags was found at the location. The found property was taken to the Police station for safe keeping.
- Officers responded to a report of a disturbance at the 1800 block of Benson Avenue. This was an argument between neighbors. No crime occurred and the parties were advised to separate.

- BCSO officer assist for a hit and run traffic accident at S Missimer Road/W Old Inland Empire Hwy. The RP stated that someone in a white SUV type vehicle had hit the stop sign and then took off. There was damage done to the stop sign. The County Roads department was advised.
