Public Safety Sales Tax Summary 2016

In 2015, the City of Prosser began collecting Public Safety Sales Tax Receipts. To ensure the controlled use and reporting of these funds, the Public Safety Sales Tax Fund (149) was established. The City of Prosser committed these to the appointment of a School Resource Officer and to support other police staff.

In 2016, the City of Prosser received a total of \$176,942.06 in public safety sales tax revenue and expended \$183,470.08. For 2017, we estimate to receive \$197,950 and to spend \$254,200. Below is an illustration of budgeted expenditures.
