

**INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR
TEMPORARY TRANSFER OF CITRIX LICENSE
CITY OF PASCO AND CITY OF PROSSER**

THIS TEMPORARY TRANSFER AGREEMENT is effective upon the date executed by all parties. In consideration of the mutual covenants below, the parties agree as follow:

1. **PARTIES.** The parties to this Agreement are City of Prosser, a political subdivision of the State of Washington, and the City of Pasco, a municipal corporation operating under the laws of the State of Washington.
2. **PURPOSE.** The City of Prosser and its police department are in need of CITRIX licenses. The City of Pasco has licenses that are not currently being used. The City of Pasco is willing to temporarily transfer 5 CITRIX licenses to the City of Prosser. This Agreement is intended to reflect the applicable terms and conditions between the parties.
3. **DURATION AND TERMINATION.** The term of this Agreement shall be effective for one year from the date of signing. This Agreement shall automatically extend for consecutive one (1) year terms, unless earlier terminated pursuant to the terms of this Agreement. Either party to this Agreement may terminate this Agreement by providing written notice of its intent to terminate to the other party. A notice of termination shall become effective one hundred eighty (180) days after service of the notice.
4. **COSTS.** During the term of this agreement the City of Pasco will not charge any rental fees for these licenses. The City of Prosser agrees to pay in full all maintenance fees and all other costs associated with these licenses, as required through Bi-PIN during the term of this Agreement.
5. **ENTIRE AGREEMENT.** The parties agree that this Agreement is the complete expression of its terms and conditions. Any oral or written representations or understandings not incorporated in this Agreement are specifically excluded.


